Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse

**RACE 1: NORTHPOINT FLEURIEU / SABOIS MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

**PLYMPTON** (D. Tourneur) - shortly after the start shifted in to obtain cover.

**COOL DESERT** (M. Collett) - on jumping away knuckled slightly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**WICKED WARRIOR** (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GOLDIE GURU** (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted **SUCCEEDANDCONQUER**. Shortly after the start shifted in to obtain cover. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

**KRUPTONITE** (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 450 metres lost its off hind plate. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100

**SUCCEEDANDCONQUER** (S. Logan) - contacted by **GOLDIE GURU** on jumping away. In the early stages raced keenly when being restrained and raced wide without cover.

**RACE 2: PEARLE BOUTIQUE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres**

**PERUVIAN EXPRESS** (S. Cahill) - hung out under pressure in the straight.

**BEAU DAN** (J. Potter) - hung out throughout the event.

**CLUB DOUBLE** (K. Crowther) - Mr A Brewster representing Trainer Mr P. Stokes was reprimanded under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Jumped away awkwardly, dipped, shifted out and brushed **NIKE BELLE**. Appeared to climb in its action for several strides in the middle stages of the event.

**RACE 2: PEARLE BOUTIQUE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres (Cont'd)**

**DARK DEXTER** (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

**SUGAR WITH THAT** (D. Tourneur) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**NIKE BELLE** (L. Neindorf) - on jumping away brushed with CLUB DOUBLE. Hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 3: ELEPHANT AND CASTLE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres**

**FENCELINE** (P. Gatt) - slow into stride. Hung out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**LOHN RANGER** (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

**GENERAL MINT** (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly.

**NEVER YOU MIND** (T. Pannell) - rider explained in relation to its disappointing performance that the gelding felt awkward in its action during the event and when asked for an effort in the vicinity of the 500 metres, failed to respond to his riding, may not have handled the uphill rise from in the vicinity of the 400 metres and was disappointed in its efforts to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a quartered heel on the near fore.

**ISSARA** (T. Voorham) - from the wide barrier was restrained and shifted in to obtain cover.

**UNDESIRE** (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**LEANNA BELLE** (J. Toeroek) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

**TINNY BAR BLUE** (K. Bishop) - rider explained in relation to the filly's disappointing performance that it may not have handled the quick backup after its run at Gawler on Wednesday, 12 February 2020 and in her opinion, raced flat in today's event and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 4: FPAG / SABOIS PLUS 0-62 HANDICAP - 2050 metres**

**MATAS** (A. Jordsjo) - slow into stride. In the vicinity of the 400 metres was inconvenienced when tightened between WALKABOUTCREEK, which rolled in and VINDEX, which rolled out.

**ACE ATTACK** (J. Toeroek) - hung in from in the vicinity of the 500 metres and for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**VINDEX** (J. Maund) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres rolled out onto MATAS.

**WALKABOUTCREEK** (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres rolled in onto MATAS.

**RACE 5: BREMERTON WINES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

**FULTON STREET** (M. Collett) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

**IGITUR** (C. Lions) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**CABLE BAY (NZ)** (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

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**RACE 5: BREMERTON WINES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1600 metres (Cont'd)**

**RUN FOR SUCCESS** - acting on confirmed advice from Co-Trainer Mr J. Frew that they would have difficulties transporting the gelding to the races and requested the scratching of RUN FOR SUCCESS. Stewards declared RUN FOR SUCCESS a late scratching at 9.12 am.

**VISAO** (J. Holder) - had its tongue-tie replaced on arrival at the barriers. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

**BIG CALL** (J. Chau) - required to be re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

**RACE 6: GIPSIE JACK CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1350 metres**

**PUTTING ON AIRS** (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Rider reported the mare was disappointed in today's event. She stated that PUTTING ON AIRS travelled well during the event, however when asked for an effort from in the vicinity of the 300 metres failed to respond to her riding as she had anticipated and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**REAP THE BENEFIT** (T. Pannell) - weakened from in the vicinity of the 400 metres despite the efforts of its rider. Rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable under pressure in the straight and for this reason he elected not to ride REAP THE BENEFIT out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Ms K. Huxtable, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

**JACK'S SISTER** (C. Lions) - shortly after the start was restrained from its wide barrier and shifted in to obtain cover.

**KARAOKE EXPRESS** (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly.

**RACE 7: MIGHTY FARM EQUINE RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

**REAL EASY** (S. Price) - approaching the 100 metres altered course to the outside of THANASI.

**DEXSTRA** (L. Neindorf) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**DELUXE DESIGN** (T. Pannell) - slow into stride.

**JACQUI ANN** (S. Logan) - proved difficult to load. Trainer Mr J. Macmillan was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung out throughout the event.

**TEATRO** (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

**PARTY SET** (J. Chau) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.
