Report on Race Meeting held at Balaklava Racecourse

RAIL: Out 5 metres 800 metres to 400 metres, true remainder.

RACE 1 : BALAKLAVA TRANSPORT MAIDEN PALTE - 1055 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

EL DUB (E. Boyd) – hung out throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JUST WALLY (S. Cahill) – jumped away awkward and inconvenienced shortly after the start.

HINCREDIBLE (J. Kah) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed signs of heat stress. First aid administered.

COMEDY PLAYHOUSE (D. Caboche) – pre-race veterinary examination of the mare (had not raced for over 12 months) - ruled fit to race. Inconvenienced shortly after the start.

ELVESINTHESTREAM (S. Price) – difficult to load. Warning issued.

SIRIUS SASS (K. Bishop) – pre-race veterinary examination of the mare (had not raced for over 12 months) - ruled fit to race. Difficult to load. Warning issued. Jumped away awkwardly.

SUPER HAPPY (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly.

GO CAROL GO (J. Toeroek) – difficult to load. Warning issued.

HOT GOSSIP (Z. Spain) - difficult to load. Warning issued. Raced keenly throughout.

RACE 2 : AGFERT / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1410 metres

CHIAZZA (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly.

CHICA CALIENTE (E. Finnegan) – hampered shortly after the start.

PIERREMONT MAGIC (R. Hurdle) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in near foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

RACE 2 : AGFERT / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1410 metres (Cont'd)

LETHAL LEGS (J. Holder) – slow into stride.

SIXTEEN AGAIN (C. Lindop) – from the vicinity of the 700 metres to the vicinity of the 400 metres was held up for clear running.

RACE 3 : AUSSIE RIPPER ROASTS / SABOIS COLTS GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1410 metres

DAPPER ROSSA (A. Doyle) – shortly after the start was inconvenienced and lost position.

STAR JOURNEY (S. Cahill) – pre-race veterinary examination revealed a minor abrasion to the off foreleg, which occurred during floating to the course - ruled fit to race.

SUPER SWIFT (J. Toeroek) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages. In the vicinity of the 900 metres was momentarily inconvenienced.

THE BRIGHTONIAN (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was inconvenienced and lost position.

TYCOON CHESTER (J. Holder) – in the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted out under pressure. Rider reminded of obligations when shifting ground.

JUST LIVE ON (W. Kerford) – in the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in under pressure. Rider reminded of obligations when shifting ground.

MEADOWS CADDY (T. Pannell) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in. Rider issued with a reprimand. Trainer Mr S. Schrader questioned regarding improved performance. He explained apart from obtaining an early and cheap lead, which was a benefit to the gelding, he could offer no explanation.

ONE FOR THE MONEY (M. Neilson) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres momentarily inconvenienced.

Following this race, Jockey J. Kah (UNLEASH ONE MORE), reported to Stewards that she had injured her foot in the barriers. She was examined by the First Care Medical officers and was stood down for the remainder of the day.

RACE 4 : WOODSTOCK RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1610 metres

GUILTY AS CHARGED (C. Jones) – rider could offer no explanation into the poor performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

INCANDESCENT (Z. Spain) – slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted out bumping another runner on a number of occasions.

ANURADHA (D. Caboche) – slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 50 metres bumped with another runner on a number of occasions.

RACE 5 : NORTH EAST ISUZU 4UP CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1410 metres

MASTER OF MONEY (P. Gatt) – performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED APPEAL (J. Holder) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres had to momentarily steady.

MR PORTER (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres shifted in marginally. Reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Apprentice R. Hurdle pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100. He also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

RACE 5 : NORTH EAST ISUZU 4UP CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1410 metres (Cont'd)

CONTESSA DREAM (Z. Spain) – was slow into stride. Rider reported mare felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an abrasion to the off side hock and a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 6 : MY BUTCHER / SABOIS PLUS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2214 metres

OUR MUMMY'S BOY (S. Cahill) – slow to begin. From the vicinity of the 600 metres to the vicinity of the 500 metres was held up for clear running.

RACE 7 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

MAGICAL TYCOON (Z. Spain) – slow to begin.

BANG FOR YA BUCK (M. Neilson) – raced greenly over the concluding stages.

SHA LA LA (D. Caboche) – slow to begin.

KOODA DAWN (K. Bishop) – struck the mounting yard enclosure en route to the start. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the mare fit to race. Jumped away awkwardly.

DUBAI SUNRISE (E. Finnegan) – a pre-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the near side hip. DUBAI SUNRISE was ruled fit to race.

RACE 8 : BTR EXCAVATIONS COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES 0-58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes.

CARDINAL MISSION (E. Finnegan) – fractious in the barriers. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the gelding fit to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

DEVARICH (J. Toeroek) – jumped away awkwardly.

RORY'S UNION (K. Bishop) – jumped away awkwardly.

SUTANOC (C. Jones) – inconvenienced shortly after the start.
