RACE 1: DOAN PHARMACIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1550 metres

BURHAN (R. Hurdle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOON ARROW (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LITTLE SWEETHEART (Z. Spain) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 2: WILLOW GROVE STUD / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to the horses arriving late at the barriers.

KASMARLAINE (B. Claridge) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped SET TO SURPRISE.

SET TO SURPRISE (D. Caboche) – bumped at the start as KASMARLAINE jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

RACE 3: STIRLING VINEYARD SERVICES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

PUFTALOON (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

SHOWMETHESUGAR – a late scratching at 1.35 pm due to the track downgrade.

HUSSARAMA (P. Gatt) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in and away from O'LONHROAD.

RACE 3: STIRLING VINEYARD SERVICES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

VOD (B. Claridge) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. In the vicinity of the 900 metres was inclined to lay in and away from TRUE LIBERTY, which shifted in. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TRUE LIBERTY (B. Griffiths) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in onto VOD, which was inclined to lay in and away onto O'LONHROAD taking that mare in onto HUSSARAMA, which shifted in and away from O'LONHROAD. As a result JUST WALLY was obliged to be steadied and lost its position. Rider reprimanded and advised in future to be mindful of riders to his inside. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

O'LONHROAD (D. Caboche) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was taken in marginally by VOD, which was inclined to lay in and away from TRUE LIBERTY, which shifted in.

JUST WALLY (L. Stojakovic) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to be steadied and lost its position as HUSSARAMA shifted in and away from O'LONHROAD, which was taken in marginally by VOD, which was inclined to lay in and away from TRUE LIBERTY, which shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: WISE FARM EQUIPMENT BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

MATERIALISED (P. Gatt) – rider explained the mare travelled well during the event and when placed under pressure was disappointing in its efforts. He added in his opinion the mare may not have handled the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NO DOUBTFIRE (B. Griffiths) – had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from in the vicinity of the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

DEVARICH – a late scratching at 1.45 pm due to the track downgrade.

RACE 5: TATIARA TRUCK & TRAILERS BENCHMARKS 60 HANDICAP - 1550 metres

SHADOWS ABOVE (H. McKechnie) – rider reported the mare may not have handled the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GAMELIST (E. Boyd) – rider reported the mare did not feel comfortable in its action during the event and may not have handled the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: HANSEN DESIGN & PRINT BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

TUNISIA TRAVELLER (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NORMANDY LAD (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STELLAR RUBY (P. Gatt) – Trainer advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to being fractious in the barriers.

PRIME FOCUS (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

HAPPYENDO (L. Stojakovic) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.

ATOMIC HERO (T. Zanker) - slow to begin.

RACE 7: FARMER'S LEAP WINES BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

LONG VIEW (S. Cahill) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

TINSLEY GREEN (L. Stojakovic) – a late scratching at 2.44 pm due to the track downgrade.

MR INQUISITIVE (D. Tourneur) – a late scratching at 2.08 pm due to the track downgrade.

TIMES LIKE THESE (NZ) (J. Potter) - a late scratching at 3.05 pm due to the track downgrade.

GHOST RIDER (J. Huxtable) - a late scratching at 2.57 pm due to the track downgrade.

STYLISH LILY (C. Puls) – rider reported the mare may not have handled the track conditions.

RACE 8: RAY WHITE REAL ESTATE BORDERTOWN BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

TRICKY ROCKET (B. Griffiths) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced for over twelve months and passed fit to race.

ARTHURIAN LEGEND (J. Huxtable) - a late scratching at 2.57 pm due to the track downgrade.

MORNIN' SAM (H. McKechnie) - slow to begin. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SVETSKI (S. Cahill) - a late scratching at 2.42 pm due to the track downgrade.

THE BLACK SUPERMAN (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Rider reported the gelding travelled well during the event but failed to let down when asked for an effort. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUICK BEERS - Late scratching at 1.08 pm due to the track downgrade.

WHITE JADE – Stewards acceded to a request from Trainer Mr J. Dunn to remove the pacifiers from the gelding in this event due to the track conditions.

RACE 4: WISE FARM EQUIPMENT BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

MOTACADE - On Monday, 17 October 2016 Trainer Mr S. Bates notified Stewards the gelding had bled from both nostrils on return to his stable. Trainer was advised the gelding was suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A.
