# RACE 1 : ROSSAIR CHARTERS / SABOIS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

THE ENGINEER (R. Hurdle) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped MAPPINGA ROSE.

**EMERALD LANE** (J. Huxtable) – inconvenienced at the start when tightened onto FILLY OF STEEL by MAPPINGA ROSE, which was taken out by THE ENGINEER. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GUMVALE MISS** (J. Toeroek) – hung in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor abrasions to both sides of the mouth.

**MAPPINGA ROSE** (B. Griffiths) – bumped at the start and taken out onto EMERALD LANE as THE ENGINEER jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

#### RACE 2: PORT LINCOLN HOTEL CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1000 metres

**GOLDEN CLASS** (K. Bishop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

# RACE 3: NEXT PAYMENTS ATMS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

**BOUTONNIERE** (R. Hurdle) – bumped at the start as CAPTAIN OASIS jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Approaching the 1000 metres shifted in onto CAPTAIN OASIS, which was obliged to be eased momentarily when tightened onto ARTFUL IGGY.

**HEZA GUNN** (J. Potter) – shortly after the start shifted out onto GOLDPHON, which lost its position when tightened onto HALLS BAY.

**BENGARA** (K. Bishop) – became fractious in its stall after arriving on course. Examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have swelling in its off foreleg and would be unfit to run. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew BENGARA at 11.48 am.

# RACE 3: NEXT PAYMENTS ATMS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 metres (cont'd)

**DANOXIE** (L. Stojakovic) – rider reported it was not her intention to lead in this event; however, after jumping well and with the addition of blinkers for the first time she found herself more forward than she had anticipated.

**GOLDPHON** (E. Boyd) – lost its position shortly after the start when tightened onto HALLS BAY as HEZA GUNN shifted out.

**CAPTAIN OASIS** (T. Zanker) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped BOUTONNIERE. Approaching the 1000 metres was obliged to be eased momentarily when tightened onto ARTFUL IGGY as BOUTONNIERE shifted in.

**HALLS BAY** (J. Toeroek) – lost its off hind plate prior to the running of this event and was re-shod. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit start.

### RACE 4: BUTTERFIELD FARMS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

BOSSA NOVA (NZ) (M. Poon) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**HEZA HUSSLER** (B. Claridge) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and at the finish line bumped ASH ROAD. Rider reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

**IN HIS DREAMS** (T. Zanker) – jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported the gelding raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ASH ROAD (J. Potter) – at the finish line bumped as HEZA HUSSLER was inclined to lay in under pressure.

### RACE 5: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

**LAST DIP** (M. Poon) – marginally slow to begin.

**DAZZLING LILLY** (J. Huxtable) – in the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to be momentarily steadied when tightened onto LAST DIP as DIVADEBEER, which was inclined to lay in under pressure, shifted in. Rider reported the mare was inclined to hang out throughout the event.

**ARTFUL MONTY** (E. Boyd) – rider reported the gelding failed to muster early speed in the event however finished the race off well.

**DIVADEBEER** (Z. Spain) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in and tightened DAZZLING LILLY, which was obliged to be momentarily steadied, onto LAST DIP.

BEARDED DRAGON (T. Zanker) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**SUPER SILKS (NZ)** (B. Griffiths) – rider reported that in his opinion the gelding may have choked down during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

### RACE 6: JP CABINETS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

**VALIK** (S. Cahill) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped I'M OUT, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to hang out under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out onto THE HARD WAY, which was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto EXTREME SHOT, which shifted in as it was weakening. Rider severely reprimanded.

**READY AGAIN** (B. Claridge) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

### RACE 6: JP CABINETS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1750 metres (cont'd)

**EXTREME SHOT** (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in when weakening onto THE HARD WAY, which was obliged to be steadied as VALIK, which was inclined to hang out shifted out. Rider reminded of her obligations when her mounts commence to shift ground in future. Approaching the finish was obliged to be eased when tightened onto VALIK as A LOTTA ROSIE shifted in and away from READY AGAIN

**DESIGNER EDITION** (D. Thornton) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor post-race recovery.

**MAXALICIOUS** (J. Potter) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

A LOTTA ROSIE (J. Huxtable) – approaching the finish shifted in and away from READY AGAIN.

**THE HARD WAY** (Z. Spain) – slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was obliged to be steadied when VALIK, which was inclined to hang out, shifted out and EXTREME SHOT, which was weakening, shifted in.

**I'M OUT** (B. Griffiths) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped VALIK, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the near hind cannon. First aid administered.

#### RACE 7: PORT LINCOLN GOURMET MEATS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes initially owing to an interstate race.

**VALUE AS** (S. Cahill) – inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

**DESTONY HAWK** (B. Griffiths) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a wound in the mare's mouth. Trainer, Ms J. Branford, advised the mare's teeth required attending to.

**MAGICAL TYCOON** (M. Poon) – shortly after the start was taken out onto PERUVIAN POWER by KOODA DUCHESS, which shifted out.

**CELEBRITY TYCOON** (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**KOODA DUCHESS** (K. Bishop) – shortly after the started shifted out onto MAGICAL TYCOON, which was taken out onto PERUVIAN POWER, which was hampered for a number of strides and lost its position when tightened onto DESTONY HAWK.

**PERUVIAN POWER** (R. Hurdle) – hampered and lost its position shortly after the start when tightened onto DESTONY HAWK by MAGICAL TYCOON.

**ZIPALANG** (D. Caboche) – difficult to load. Trainer, Ms A. Cornell, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its manners.

**SILVER EAGLE** (E. Boyd) – rider reported that her mount didn't feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 8: BRIAN HARVEY AGENCIES BENCHMARK 80 HCP - 1390 metres

**PROPSHAFT** (J. Potter) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres rolled out and bumped NEW WAVE.

NEW WAVE (E. Boyd) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres bumped with PROPSHAFT, which rolled out.

### RACE 9: MOGAS MORTLOCK SERVICE STATION BENCHMARK 72 HCP - 1000m

**DIRE WARNING** (E. Boyd) – inclined to hang in under pressure in the straight and approaching the finish shifted in abruptly away from COSMIC KHELEYF which was inclined to lay in onto SUTANOC, which was obliged to check and lost its position when tightened onto GEORDIE'S SECOND, which shifted out and away from HEAVENS FLIGHT, which shifted out abruptly. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to make a greater effort when her mounts hang in, in future.

**GEORDIE'S SECOND** (B. Claridge) – approaching the finish shifted out and away from HEAVENS FLIGHT, which shifted out abruptly.

**TINTAGEL ROCKER** (B. Griffiths) – raced keenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate.

**ALL KRUPT** (Z. Spain) – bumped at the start as HEAVENS FLIGHT jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

**HEAVENS FLIGHT** (J. Potter) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped ALL KRUPT. Approaching the finish shifted out abruptly onto GEORDIE'S SECOND. Rider reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

**SUTANOC** (K. Bishop) – approaching the finish was obliged to check and lost its position as DIRE WARNING, which was inclined to hang in, shifted in and away from COSMIC KHELEYF, which was inclined to lay in, and became tightened onto GEORDIE'S SECOND, which shifted out and away from HEAVENS FLIGHT, which shifted out abruptly.

**COSMIC KHELEYF** (J. Huxtable) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.
