Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse
by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 2 July 2017

RACE 1: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1550 metres

MISTA KNOWITALL (S. Fawke) – slow into stride.

FALIE (H. McKechnie) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed mild speedy cuts on both hind pasterns.

RACE 2: ALLENDALE STUDS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1300 metres

EXALTED EDWARD (B. Griffiths) - in the vicinity of the 700 metres was momentarily inconvenienced as LADY DEE DEE rolled out.

PART THE SEA (J. Andreou) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and inconvenienced LADY DEE DEE.

LIGHTNING TIARA (D. Thornton) – inside the 200 metres was reluctant to improve into a run between EXALTED EDWARD and DUPORTRON. Rider reported the mare failed to travel throughout the event despite his efforts and when asked to improve in the vicinity of the 600 metres failed to respond how he anticipated and was disappointing in its efforts to the finish. He added LIGHTNING TIARA was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIGNATURE DISH (A. Jordsjo) – was inclined to lay in under pressure from rounding the home turn until the finish.

ALPHA STRYKE (H. McKechnie) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out contacting MAGIC STRYKES, which lost its position.

LADY DEE DEE (T. Germaine) – inconvenienced at the start as PART THE SEA jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. In the vicinity of the 700 metres rolled out and momentarily inconvenienced EXALTED EDWARD.

MAGIC STRYKES (Z. Spain) – lost its position at the start when tightened onto CATCH US as ALPHA STRYKE jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 3: LOCAL BOOKMAKERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

FAMILJA (K. Crowther) – inclined to hang out under pressure in the straight.

MEADOWS VIV (V. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ELMO RULZ.

RACE 3: LOCAL BOOKMAKERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres (Cont'd)

ELMO RULZ (K. Bishop) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted MEADOWS VIV.

LANDOWNER (J. Potter) – from in the vicinity of the 150 metres was inclined to shift out and away from FAMILJA, which hung out under pressure in the straight, onto LAUREN, which was weakening and inclined to lay in and lost its position when tightened onto RAMBLER FURY. J. Potter was reprimanded and advised to straighten his mounts sooner in similar circumstances in future.

SANDHILL HALO (J. Huxtable) – On jumping away bumped with RAMBLER FURY, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Trainer Mr S. Turner was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to it being difficult to load.

TRAMPS LIKE US (T. Germaine) – Ms J. Banks was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to it being difficult to load.

ARTISTIC ESCAPE (Z. Spain) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and inside the 100 metres shifted in onto RAMBLER FURY, which shifted in and away from ARTISTIC ESCAPE and was obliged to be checked and lost its position as LANDOWNER shifted out and away from FAMILJA. Z. Spain was severely reprimanded and advised to straighten his mounts sooner in similar circumstances in future.

LAUREN (B. Claridge) – weakened from inside the 200 metres and was inclined to lay in. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied and lost its position when tightened by LANDOWNER, which was inclined to shift out and away from FAMILJA and RAMBLER FURY, which shifted in and away from ARTISTIC ESCAPE.

RAMBLER FURY (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped SANDHILL HALO. Inside the 100 metres was obliged to be checked and lost its position as it shifted in and away from ARTISTIC ESCAPE, which was inclined to lay in at the same time as LANDOWNER shifted out and away from FAMILJA.

RACE 4: WILLOW GROVE STUD BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1550 metres

MOON ARROW (J. Potter) - slow to begin.

VENI VIDI VICI (B. Griffiths) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROSE OF WADHAM (B. Claridge) – slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer Mr L. McDonald was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 5: UPPER SE LIQUID WASTE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

EASTERN PEGASUS (J. Andreou) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Momentarily held up for a short distance when rounding the home turn when racing between CALL ME PENNY and MYKONOS.

MASTER BLACK (K. Crowther) – approaching the finish inclined to lay in, shifted in and bumped CALL ME PENNY, turning the hindquarters of MASTER BLACK out. As a result, AKERBOY, which was racing to the inside of CALL ME PENNY was hampered and obliged to be steadied when tightened onto EASTERN PEGASUS. K. Crowther was severely reprimanded and advised to straighten her mounts sooner in similar circumstances in future.

MYKONOS (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AKERBOY (B. Griffiths) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the finish line when weakening was hampered and obliged to be steadied when tightened onto EASTERN PEGASUS as CALL ME PENNY was taken in by MASTER BLACK. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore fetlock. Trainer Mr J. Searle was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to a future trial or race. First aid administered.

RACE 5: UPPER SE LIQUID WASTE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

CALL ME PENNY (J. Maund) – approaching the finish was taken in and bumped with MASTER BLACK and as a consequence was taken in onto AKERBOY, which was obliged to be steadied.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow B. Griffiths (AKERBOY) placed fourth and Trainer Mr J. Searle to view the vision in the straight.

RACE 6: TATIARA INDUSTRIAL REPAIRS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

BARGE AND CHARGE (A. Jordsjo) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BRAIDLEY (IRE) (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COSTA LANTE (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED JOURNEY (B. Griffiths) – slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: PJ & LE MURCH BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

SHY FRANK (J. Andreou) – bumped at the start by GRUMPY GURU, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

RED BEGONIA (S. Cahill) – had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from shortly after the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

GRUMPY GURU (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped SHY FRANK.

LORDFONTEIN (D. Bates) - slow to begin.

RED MENACE (D. Thornton) – raced in restricted room from shortly after the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 50 metres when racing between REEF'S REVENGE and SHY FRANK.

DAPPER AFTER DARK (T. Germaine) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding suffered a bi-lateral bleeding attack. Trainer Mr M. Vassallo was advised the mare was now suspended from racing for a period of three (3) months in accordance with AR53A.

KLOSS (B. Claridge) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IT'S FINE NOW (B. Griffiths) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
