STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

MORPHETTVILLE – THURSDAY, 14 SEPTEMBER 2017

Stewards have inquired into the substance *11-nor-delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid* being detected in a urine sample provided by licensed stable employee Jason Sweeney at Morphettville on Monday, 1 August 2017.

Evidence was taken from Jason Sweeney and a report tendered by Racing Analytical Services Limited, in relation to this sample, was considered.

After considering the evidence taken, Jason Sweeney pleaded guilty to an offence under ARR.81AA(1)(a) in that the sample he provided contained *11-nor-delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid*, a substance banned under ARR.81BB. His Stable Employee license was suspended from Monday, 28 August 2017, the date on which he was stood down following notification of the irregularity, until midnight Saturday, 28 October 2017; a period of two (2) months.

He was informed that under ARR.81AA(4) he can only resume handling horses after providing a urine sample free of banned substances.

Jason Sweeney was advised of his right of appeal.
