STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Murray Bridge Racecourse
by the Murray Bridge Racing Club on Wednesday, 10 January 2018

Stewards: J. Petzer (Chairman), M. Santoro (HT), & A. Hayles (F), (Stewards), M. Williams (M), K. Lemay-Robbins & T. Vanderstok (Cadet Stewards), Dr P. Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 3

WEATHER: Overcast / Fine

RAIL: Out 3 metres 1000 metres to the Winning Post, true remainder

RACE 1: SAMBEC SHEDS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1006 metres

LE DEZALEY (S. Fawke) – very awkward and slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 700 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of LI'L EAG as that horse was being restrained.

TSAVORITE (R. Clark) – laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore leg (near fore tendon strain). First aid administered. Trainer, Mr K. Healy, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

JUST THIS ONE (K. Crowther) – rider reported that the gelding hung out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LI'L EAG (V. Wong) – awkward to begin. Near the 700 metres, when racing ungenerously, became awkwardly placed on the heels of AMBERTONE, and as a consequence had to be restrained.

VOD (T. Pannell) – had to be re-saddled at the start. Began awkwardly and shifted out onto AMBERTONE, inconveniencing that horse.

AMBERTONE (J. Potter) – inconvenienced at the start.

RACE 2: C U AFTER THE LAST @ SWANPORT HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1206 metres

MAXSAMIA (K. Bishop) – shifted in at the start contacting IT'S A FIREBALL.

TICKET TO TEXAS (K. Crowther) – laid in, in the early stages of the event and near the 1100 metres shifted in onto BURST OF FAITH, tightening that horse for a number of strides.

VALAROMA (S. Fawke) – proved difficult to load.

IT'S A FIREBALL (A. Chan) – awkward to begin and thereafter contacted by MAXSAMIA, which shifted in. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$500.

JOHN THE RODENT (J. Potter) – awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted BELLE IMAGE.

TIME RULER (R. Clark) – awkward to begin.

BELLE IMAGE (E. Boyd) – contacted at the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LACE THE LADY (Jemma Frew) – raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

MOODY MISS (J. Holder) – proved difficult on arrival at the barriers. Trainer, Mrs H. Lehmann, was advised that a warning had been placed on the horse in relation to its manners at the barriers.

RACE 2: C U AFTER THE LAST @ SWANPORT HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE
- 1206 metres (cont'd)

RESISTA (A. Jordsjo) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

BURST OF FAITH (B. Paterson) – near the 1100 metres raced in restricted room for a short distance between TICKET TO TEXAS, which laid in and shifted in, and JOHN THE RODENT, to its inside.

RACE 3: DAISH IRRIGATION & FODDER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1606 metres

CRY WOLF (D. Tourneur) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FANDANGO (E. Boyd) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Held up for a short distance near the entrance to the straight.

LAST ONE NAMED (A. Chan) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground shortly after the entrance to the straight when racing behind CRY WOLF, which was weakening, and was only able to obtain clear running from in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

MAN OF IRON (P. Gatt) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

WANTED HARMONY (J. Toeroek) – laid out from shortly after the start until near the entrance to the straight.

CRYSTAL CHOICE (A. Jordsjo) – awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: WWW.RACINGMURRAYBRIDGE.COM BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1606 metres

ART MUSIC (A. Chan) – in the vicinity of the 1300 metres was contacted by MAXALICIOUS and hampered.

PLAYFELLOW (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 1300 metres shifted in slightly and thereafter had difficulty obtaining clear running from shortly after the entrance to the straight until approaching the 100 metres.

KOSMOS TERCEDES (J. Holder) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COOL TARGET (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 1300 metres raced in restricted room to the inside of PLAYFELLOW, which shifted in slightly as the pace slowed and as a consequence shifted in onto MAXALICIOUS.

BRAEVIEW MISS (R. Clark) – race keenly in the early stages of the event.

ALWAYS MAGIC (J. Potter) – saddle shifted sideways, to the near side, in running placing J. Potter at a disadvantage.

MAXALICIOUS (K. Crowther) – over-raced in the early stages of the event and in the vicinity 1300 metres raced in restricted room for a short distance to the inside of COOL TARGET, which shifted in slightly when taken in by PLAYFELLOW as the pace slowed, and as a consequence had to be checked and clipped the heels of COOL TARGET. Thereafter shifted in and contacted ART MUSIC, hampering that horse.

RACE 5: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 904 metres

CLASSY JACK (A. Chan) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

RACE 5: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 904 metres (Cont'd)

CRYSTAL MOMENT (O. Ridge) – awkward to begin and shifted in onto OUTBACK TYCOON making contact with that horse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OGUNDE (A. Lindsay) – laid out in the straight. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour, reported that on return to scale, on inspection, the tongue tie fitted to OGUNDE was found to be loose.

WILANDER PRINCESS (K. Bishop) – laid out over the concluding stages.

OUTBACK TYCOON (A. Jordsjo) – inconvenienced at the start when contacted by CRYSTAL MOMENT, which shifted in.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow A. Chan (CLASSY JACK) and trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, to view the official vision in the straight.

RACE 6: UBET / SABOIS PLUS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2206 metres

WICKED RHYTHM (K. Crowther) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 1500 metres clipped the heels of HENRY THE DOLPHIN and stumbled.

CASINO CLUB (P. Gatt) – shifted in, in the vicinity of the 300 metres onto SPYING ON YOU (NZ), which was inconvenienced. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

RUTH (S. Fawke) – passing the winning post on the first occasion rolled out and brushed with WATCH THE WOLF.

WATCH THE WOLF (Jemma Frew) – shortly after the start, in the vicinity of the 2100 metres, shifted in when improving its position and crossed the running of HIGH ROLLA, which was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of WATCH THE WOLF. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight Thursday, 18 January and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 24 January 2018, a period of three meetings. Passing the winning post on the first occasion was brushed by RUTH, which rolled out, and had its hindquarters turned. In the vicinity of the 300 metres rolled out and inconvenienced SPYING ON YOU (NZ), rider reprimanded under AR137(a) and advised to take greater care when her mounts commence to shift ground.

CASIRAGHI (B. Paterson) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AALI MIA (E. Boyd) – awkward to begin.

PRINCESS COSTA (R. Clark) – awkward to begin.

SPYING ON YOU (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until approaching the 300 metres and shortly thereafter was forced to take hold when racing between WATCH THE WOLF and CASINO CLUB, which both shifted ground.

RACE 7: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1406 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to difficulty being experienced fitting the ear muffs to DAKTARI.

ZALMONA (A. Jordsjo) – rider dislodged en route to the barriers. A. Jordsjo was examined by the First Care Medical personnel on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to ride. Approaching the 100 metres rolled in and became awkward on the heels of CONNERMARA ROSE for a number of strides and had to be steadied.

EXALTED TRAVELLER (D. Tourneur) – held up for clear running from the 300 metres to the 100 metres.

RACE 7: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1406 metres (cont'd)

CONNERMARA ROSE (K. Crowther) – rolled out approaching the 100 metres.

FORT NECESSITY (P. Gatt) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: AUSTRALIA DAY RACES @ MURRAY BRIDGE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1206 metres

BELEAGUER (S. Fawke) – obliged to alter course to the inside of MILLENIA approaching the 100 metres.

EVIL PRINCESS (C. Lindop) – awkward to begin.

JUST RESTING (A. Jordsjo) – contacted at the start.

SHARK MIRAGE (J. Holder) – taken wider for a short distance near the 800 metres.

HIGHLAND HENRY (E. Boyd) – rider reported the gelding felt short in its action form in the vicinity of the 350 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPIRITED MATCH (D. Tourneur) – awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted JUST RESTING. Near the 800 metres made the turn awkwardly taking SHARK MIRAGE wider for a short distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
