Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse

RACE 1: THETERRACEFUNCTIONCENTRE.COM.AU CLASS TWO HANDICAP – 1508 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to a delay with an interstate race (Queanbeyan).

IMPULSE DIAVOLO (K. Crowther) – near the vicinity of the 800 metres rolled in and inconvenienced SWEET DESIGN for a number of strides. Performed below market expectations. Rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S GOT SKILLS (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted out and improved around the field to take up the lead.

SWEET DESIGN (E. Boyd) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres inconvenienced for a number of strides as IMPULSE DIAVOLO rolled in.

RACE 2: GOLDIN FARMS-AKEED MOFEED / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1208 metres

EQUIDAME (J. Bowditch) –raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

NIGHT QUEEN (D. Tourneur) – held up for clear running in the vicinity of the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 150 metres.

RACE 3: SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE MAIDEN PLATE - 1208 metres

DARRYL'S LIBERTY (E. Boyd) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it contacted a perimeter fence on exiting the mounting yard and passed fit to race. Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

RACE 3: SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE MAIDEN PLATE - 1208 metres (Cont'd)

FERINGO (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Rounding the home turn was inclined to lay in, shifted in and bumped **SILENT SUNDAY**, which was inclined to hang out. Rider reported the gelding travelled well during the event, however given the month between runs **FERINGO** only laboured over the concluding stages. He added, in his opinion, **FERINGO** would benefit from racing over further distances. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HURRY HOME HARRY (J. Toeroek) – inside the 100 metres was taken out by **MISS EBONY ROSE**, which rolled out marginally.

LORD ROSENTHAL (J. Bowditch) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres was inconvenienced momentarily when **WARY GLANCE**, which was racing greenly rolled out.

WARY GLANCE (D. Caboche) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres, when racing greenly, rolled out onto **LORD ROSENTHAL**, which was inconvenienced momentarily. Rider reported the gelding raced greenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS EBONY ROSE (K. Bishop) – inside the 100 metres rolled out onto **HURRY HOME HARRY**.

SILENT SUNDAY (G. Lo) – rounding the home turn, when inclined to hang out, shifted out and bumped **FERINGO**, which was inclined to lay in. Approaching the 200 metres bumped with **CHAMPERS ON ICE**, which was hanging in and shifted in, on a number of occasions.

CHAMPERS ON ICE (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly. Hung in under pressure in the straight and approaching the 200 metres shifted in and bumped **SILENT SUNDAY** on a number of occasions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZAVILLA (K. Crowther) – inside the 100 metres was inconvenienced when tightened onto **LORD ROSENTHAL**, which rolled in and **HURRY HOME HARRY**, which was taken out by **MISS EBONY ROSE**, which rolled out marginally.

RACE 4: KINGSFORD HOTEL / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1108 metres

LIL' CHILLI (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly.

BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS (T. Pannell) – Near the 800 metres was taken wider by **LITTLE MINKIA**, which was racing greenly and shifted out. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was taken wider by **DUCHESS GRACE** which shifted out.

DUCHESS GRACE (J. Bowditch) – held up for clear running from approaching the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres and shifted out to obtain clear running and in doing so took **BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS** wider on the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GALCRUM (D. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped **LITTLE MINKIA**. Held up for clear running approaching the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres. From thereafter hung in under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LITTLE MINKIA (R. Clark) – lost its position on jumping away when awkwardly placed on the heels of **ALL THINGS** due to **GALCRUM** jumping away awkwardly and shifting out. Near the 800 metres when racing greenly shifted out taking **BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS** wider on the track. Shortly after shifted in onto **STREETCAR CLASSIC**, which was inconvenienced when tightened onto **GALCRUM**. Rider reported the filly raced extremely greenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STREETCAR CLASSIC (P. Gatt) - slow to begin. Inside the 800 metres was inconvenienced when tightened onto **GALCRUM** as **LITTLE MINKIA**, which was racing greenly shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1708 metres

HE'S A VALLEYBOY (A. Chan) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 50 metres was inconvenienced when awkwardly placed on the heels of **ESCALATOR (NZ)**.

RACE 5: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1708 metres (Cont'd)

HEZ A WOLF (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ESCALATOR (NZ) (J. Bowditch) - slow to begin. Held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

BORTA TICKET (D. Caboche) – rider accidentally dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 200 metres. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) for carelessness in dropping his whip and was reprimanded.

CAUSE WE CAN (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

BLUE BALLOONS (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ONLINE GIRL (J. Holder) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres became awkward in its action for a number of strides and lost ground before regaining its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: HOLDFAST INSURANCE CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1108 metres

SURF 'N' TURF (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of GOLDPHON and was obliged to shift out. At the entrance to the straight shifted out and hampered LUCKY WICK for a number of strides when tightened onto MISTY HALO. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) and advised to exercise more care in future.

LUCKY WICK (J. Kah) – was hampered at the entrance to the straight when SURF 'N' TURF shifted out at the same time as MISTY HALO rolled in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUIDDICK (J. Toeroek) – shifted out under pressure in the straight.

MISTY HALO (D. Tournour) – rolled in at the entrance to the straight onto LUCKY WICK, which was hampered at the same time as SURF 'N' TURF shifted out. Rider reminded of his obligations under AR137(a).

GOLDPHON (K. Lau) – approaching the 800 metres became awkward in its action and lost ground and as a result, SURF 'N' TURF, which was trailing GOLDPHON became awkwardly placed on that mares heels and was obliged to shift out.

RACE 7: COOPERS SESSION ALE / SABOIS PLUS BENCHMARK 75 HANDICAP - 2108 metres

CHESTNUT CHARLIE (R. Clark) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHOSEN ANGEL (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly.

PIPPPOS (K. Bishop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KIRCHNER (A. Lindsay) – Stewards questioned rider in relation to her tactics in today's event. She explained her instructions were to race on pace, allowing the gelding to stride along and if another runner was looking to lead, then not to encourage the gelding. She added that she found the lead easily shortly after the start and in her opinion, the gelding travelled well during the event and was comfortable in its action and breathing. She stated that she was not aware of how far she was in front and looked behind on two occasions, first at the 1600 metres and then again in the vicinity of the 1100 metres. She stated that she was surprised as to how far in front she was, as she had not encouraged or altered her hold of KIRCHNER and felt the pace she set was reasonable. Trainer Mr A. Day confirmed the instructions and added he advised A. Lindsay that the mare may race keenly due to it being fresh as KIRCHNER has not raced for approximately 6 weeks.

RACE 8: BAROSSA CUP WEDNESDAY 23 MAY - WINEMAKERS DAY BENCHMARK 56
HANDICAP - 1208 metres

WITH GRAVY (K. Crowther) – rider could offer no explanation into the performance of the gelding in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ATARARTZI (J. Potter) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

ARCTIC BLAZE (J. Toeroek) – raced in restricted room in the vicinity of the 500 metres for a short distance when racing between SAMSTAG and SILICONNI. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWEET VARDEN (S. Fawke) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance on entering the straight.

ZAAZOE (G. Lo) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

MORCHOWIE MISS (R. Clark) – difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance on entering the straight.
