**ADDITIONAL STEWARDS' REPORT – A DOYLE**

**MORPHETTVILLE – TUESDAY, 5 JUNE 2018**

On Tuesday, 5 June 2018 Thoroughbred Racing SA Stewards inquired into the substances *d*-amphetamine and *d*-methamphetamine, being detected in a urine sample provided by Apprentice Jockey Ashley Doyle after riding at Port Lincoln Racecourse on Wednesday, 8 November 2017.

Evidence was taken from Ashley Doyle and a report tendered by Racing Analytical Services Limited, in relation to this sample, was considered.

After considering the evidence taken, Ashley Doyle pleaded guilty to a charge under Rule AR81A(1)(a) in that the banned substances *d*-amphetamine and *d*-methamphetamine were detected in the urine sample provided by him on Wednesday, 8 November 2017.

Ashley Doyle was suspended from riding in races, trials, jump-outs and all horse handling activities for a period of twelve months to commence at midnight Monday, 4 December 2017, the date on which he was stood down from all horse handling activities, until midnight Tuesday, 4 December 2018. After taking into account specific circumstances, his forthright evidence and guilty plea Stewards determined that Ashley Doyle would be permitted to ride trackwork and resume horse handling activities from midnight Tuesday, 4 September 2018, the final three months of his suspension.

Ashley Doyle was advised of his right of appeal.
