Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Wednesday, 11 July 2018

TRACK: Soft 5 (*Downgraded to Soft 6 at 10.55 am*)

WEATHER: Fine.

RAIL: Out 6 metres 1000 metres to the Winning Post, out 3 metres remainder.

RACE 1: HUGHES LIMOUSINES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 metres

BERNIE (K. Bishop) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

HABANERO (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by JACK'S SISTER which was taken out by SCOUT'S HONOUR.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (J. Potter) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after kicking a fence in the parade ring and was passed fit to start. Raced greenly on entering the straight and in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out taking JACK'S SISTER wider on the track.

VOLUM (J. Holder) – began awkwardly shifting out.

WONDER IF (NZ) (P. Gatt) – slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

LANNISTER GOLD (A. Chan) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

ANNIFRID (T. Pannell) – when questioned regarding the performance of the filly rider reported that his mount failed to travel at any stage of the event. He added that from the vicinity of the 700 metres ANNIFRID commenced to weaken. He further reported that ANNIFRID made respiratory noises on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor skin abrasion to the off hind fetlock.

JACK'S SISTER (E. Finnegan) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres was taken wider when SCOUT'S HONOUR shifted out. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 2: AAMI SPRING CARNIVAL AT MORPHETTVILLE OCT 20-NOV 6 / SABOIS MAIDEN – 1550 metres

COBBERS MATE (S. Cahill) – required to be re-shod at the barriers after losing a plate en route. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Knuckled on jumping away.

ROBBERY (E. Finnegan) – began awkwardly shifting in. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 2: AAMI SPRING CARNIVAL AT MORPHETTVILLE OCT 20-NOV 6 / SABOIS MAIDEN – 1550 metres (cont'd)

CAFFE ROMANO (R. Hurdle) – hampered on jumping away by CHARLIELOVEIT, which shifted out. Lost its near fore plate in running.

CHARLIELOVEIT (K. Bishop) – shifted out on jumping away hampering CAFFE ROMANO.

INDIAN MO (D. Tootell) – raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

MANILOW (P. Gatt) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be restrained after improving onto the heels of EUREKA SKY.

SEATTLE SOUND (R. Sakai) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres began to over-race and raced with its head up for a number of strides.

SHIRLEY'S EAGLE (J. Bowditch) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

THRONES (J. Huxtable) – rider reported his mount laid in throughout the event.

DON'T DOUBT IT (J. Potter) – over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

EUREKA SKY (K. Crowther) – over-raced in the middle stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear running on entering the straight.

SENTRY GATE (A. Chan) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious en route to the course and was passed fit to start.

RACE 3: IRISH RACE DAY - 1ST SEPTEMBER AT MORPHETTVILLE BM60 HANDICAP – 2250 metres

TABLE OF WISDOM (A. Jordsjo) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANURADHA (S. Cahill) – began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BALTIC PRINCE (P. Gatt) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

EVERY BREATH (E. Boyd) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

STAR WARS (NZ) (J. Bowditch) – over-raced in the middle stages of the event. Held up for clear running on entering the straight.

SUDDEN MOMENT (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres was disappointed for a run and had to shift in to improve into clear running.

OCCIDENT (NZ) (A. Chan) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

ITCHYZARIZ (E. Finnegan) – rider reported that her mount felt awkward in its action throughout the event and as a result she elected not to place ITCHYZARIZ under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: SEE THE MAGIC OF MATT TARRANT AT MORPHETTVILLE BM60 HANDICAP - 1250 metres

BEL STREAK (S. Cahill) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

DEXELATION (A. Chan) – began awkwardly.

SCRAP DRAGON (J. Holder) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: SEE THE MAGIC OF MATT TARRANT AT MORPHETTVILLE BM60 HANDICAP –
1250 metres (cont'd)

MASTER BLACK (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be restrained after improving onto heels.

RUG RAT (J. Potter) – late scratching at 12.30 on veterinary advice that the gelding was lame in the near hind leg. Co-trainer, Mr T. Dansie & Ms N. Storr, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

MANHATTAN MELODY (R. Hurdle) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

VIKINGS REWARD (P. Gatt) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider stated that his mount felt awkward in its action throughout the event and finished off in a disappointing manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEACRAFT (A. Jordsjo) – rider reported that in her opinion the filly failed to handle today's track conditions.

RACE 5: AAMI CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1000 metres

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (E. Finnegan) – slow to begin.

LOCKDOWN JACK (K. Crowther) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after not competing for the past twelve months and was passed fit to start.

BWUVA (R. Sakai) – held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 500 metres until approaching the 200 metres. Stewards questioned the starter in relation to BWUVA wearing pre-race ear muffs in today's event. As BWUVA ran third Stewards declared correct weight and advised the starter in future to remove pre-race earmuffs prior to loading horses into the gates.

SILENT ICE (R. Hurdle) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

HARLEM CHILD (A. Jordsjo) – Stewards considered a submission from Trainer, Mr S. Burford, that the mare be declared a late scratching owing to him only becoming aware today of a notice published by TRSA Stewards on 26 Jun 2018 in relation to the use of products containing Altrenogest. He added that due to the fact that he had only become aware of the notification today he had used a product containing Altrenogest in the lead up to today's event. After considering his explanation Stewards acceded to the request and declared HARLEM CHILD a late scratching at 10.35 am.

OUR WITNESS (K. Bishop) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GENERAL SEPOY (E. Boyd) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed a superficial laceration to the left hind fetlock.

RACE 6: HEINEKEN 3 CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1550 metres

LAURE ME IN (J. Holder) – began awkwardly. Laid in, in the early stages of the event.

EWAN MINE (K. Crowther) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after making contact with a gate en route to the barriers and was passed fit to start. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

HUNGRY FOR LOVE (J. Potter) – hampered on entering the straight after LASANT was taken in by ASHADY HUSSY.

ASHADY HUSSY (P. Gatt) – laid in entering the straight taking LASANTA in onto HUNGRY FOR LOVE, which was hampered.

EL GRECO (E. Boyd) – raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: HEINEKEN 3 CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1550 metres (cont'd)

LASANTA (O. Ridge) – on entering the straight was taken in onto HUNGRY FOR LOVE by ASHADY HUSSY.

RACE 7: SCHWEPPE / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

GOLD BLUSH (K. Crowther) – acting on advice from trainer, Mr W. Clarken, that the mare was lame in the near foreleg, Stewards withdrew GOLD BLUSH at 9.50 am. Mr Clarken was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

AUTUMN STREET (J. Huxtable) – began awkwardly.

HILUMIERE (K. Bishop) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

NIGHT QUEEN (J. Holder) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had suffered a bilateral bleeding attack. Trainer, Mr S. Coombs, was advised that as this was the mare's first bleeding attack NIGHT QUEEN would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

BIG CALL (J. Potter) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

PANDEIA (D. Tourneur) – when questioned regarding the performance of the mare rider stated that his mount travelled well throughout the event but in his opinion is not suited to 1300 metres and would be benefited by racing over shorter distances. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 8: UBET BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

HOLY JUAN (A. Jordsjo) – laid out rounding the home turn.

LAST WITNESS (R. Sakai) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Lost its off fore plate in running.

RUPTURE (J. Huxtable) – began awkwardly shifting out and making contact with ZERO PATIENCE. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was hampered by FORCE OF THREE, which shifted in abruptly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOUBLE POCKETS (S. Cahill) – shortly after jumping away was hampered by LYNCH MOB, which was taken in by ARDIZZONE. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was hampered when FORCE OF THREE shifted in abruptly taking RUPTURE in onto LYNCH MOB, which was taken in onto DOUBLE POCKETS.

STRYKER FORTUNE (P. Gatt) – rider was reprimanded under AR137(d) for excessively slowing the pace in the vicinity of the 1100 metres resulting in ARDIZZONE being hampered. Laid out under pressure rounding the home turn.

LYNCH MOB (J. Holder) – shortly after jumping away was taken in onto DOUBLE POCKETS by ARDIZZONE, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was hampered after FORCE OF THREE shifted in abruptly taking RUPTURE in onto LYNCH MOB. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARDIZZONE (K. Crowther) – shortly after jumping away shifted in when insufficiently clear of LYNCH MOB, which was taken in onto DOUBLE POCKETS, which was hampered. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of STRYKER FORTUNE when the pace slowed.

RACE 8: UBET BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1400 metres (cont'd)

FORCE OF THREE (D. Tourneur) – began awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of its rider hampering RUPTURE, which was taken in onto LYNCH MOB, which was taken in onto DOUOBLE POCKETS. Trainer, Mr J. Dodgson, was advised that the gelding would be required to complete two consecutive trials to the Stewards satisfaction in race day gear from the outside gate prior to a future race start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZERO PATIENCE (E. Finnegan) – hampered on jumping away.

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RACE 8: UBET BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

HOLY JUAN (A. Jordsjo) – laid out rounding the home turn.

LAST WITNESS (R. Sakai) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Lost its off fore plate in running.

RUPTURE (J. Huxtable) – began awkwardly shifting out and making contact with ZERO PATIENCE. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was hampered by FORCE OF THREE, which shifted in abruptly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOUBLE POCKETS (S. Cahill) – shortly after jumping away was hampered by LYNCH MOB, which was taken in by ARDIZZONE. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was hampered when FORCE OF THREE shifted in abruptly taking RUPTURE in onto LYNCH MOB, which was taken in onto DOUBLE POCKETS.

STRYKER FORTUNE (P. Gatt) – rider was reprimanded under AR137(d) for excessively slowing the pace in the vicinity of the 1100 metres resulting in ARDIZZONE being hampered. Laid out under pressure rounding the home turn.

LYNCH MOB (J. Holder) – shortly after jumping away was taken in onto DOUBLE POCKETS by ARDIZZONE, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was hampered after FORCE OF THREE shifted in abruptly taking RUPTURE in onto LYNCH MOB. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARDIZZONE (K. Crowther) – shortly after jumping away shifted in when insufficiently clear of LYNCH MOB, which was taken in onto DOUBLE POCKETS, which was hampered. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of STRYKER FORTUNE when the pace slowed.

RACE 8: UBET BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1400 metres (cont'd)

FORCE OF THREE (D. Tourneur) – began awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of its rider hampering RUPTURE, which was taken in onto LYNCH MOB, which was taken in onto DOUOBLE POCKETS. Trainer, Mr J. Dodgson, was advised that the gelding would be required to complete two consecutive trials to the Stewards satisfaction in race day gear from the outside gate prior to a future race start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
