STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORTReport on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse  
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Friday, 14 December 2018

**RACE 1: SABOIS PLUS MAIDEN/ CLASS ONE PLATE THREE -YEAR-OLD & UP - 2014 metres**

**BUSKER'S BALLAD** (J Kah) - shifted out and away from RED RAIDER at the start and brushed with BLUE BALLOONS taking that horse wider. Lost its near hind plate during the event. Rider explained that she would have preferred to settle one pair closer but owing to the gelding proving a little reluctant to travel in the early part of the event, she was unable to do so. She added the horse only commenced to pick up the bridle near the 500 metres and finished the race off very well. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GOOD IDEA** (T Pannell) - inconvenienced at the start.

**PAT THE WEAPON** (J Maund) - awkward to begin, shifted out and inconvenienced GOOD IDEA. Near the 1800 metres shifted in taking BLUE BALLOONS inwards and inconveniencing that horse. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground. Laid out from rounding the home turn until the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RED RAIDER** (J Holder) - rider reported the gelding felt awkward in its action during the event. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Co-Trainer Mr L. Macdonald was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

**MANILOW** (D Tournour) - inconvenienced at the start. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

**BLUE BALLOONS** (E Boyd) - lost its off hind plate during the event. Brushed at the start and shifted out onto MANILOW. Near the 1800 metres was obliged to be steadied when taken in and tightened by PAT THE WEAPON, which shifted in.

**STALAGMITE** (J Toeroek) - slow to begin.

**RACE 2: TAB/ SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD C&G MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres**

**CANIDAE** (S Fawke) - awkward to begin, shifted in and brushed KIROSHIMA.

**DUNKIRK** (J Holder) - laid in severely in the straight and raced greenly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GONE TO PRINT** (C Castera) - slow into stride. Inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

**KIROSHIMA** (R Hurdle) - awkward to begin. Shifted out and brushed CANIDAE.

**RACE 3: GEOFF MERRILL WINES/ SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres**

**CALYPSO STORM** (K Bishop) - very awkward to begin.

**CERTAIN SUCCESS** (S Fawke) - awkward to begin, shifted in and contacted MISS FLATLEY, which shifted out. As a consequence was hampered and shifted out and contacted the hindquarters of MAGNETIC ROSE and thereafter was buffeted between MAGNETIC ROSE and MISS FLATLEY for a number of strides.

**JAAMINT** (J Holder) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted STAR PARFAIT.

**MABEL JOSEPHINE** (J B Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**MAGNETIC ROSE** (R J Hurdle) - rider reported the filly hung out during the event. Contacted at the start and had its hindquarters turned. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MISS FLATLEY** (E Finnegan) - shifted out at the start. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that as a consequence of the filly over-racing early, she had difficulty controlling the horse.

**ONYA BOSS** (T Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SILVER JEWEL** (D Tourneur) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**STAR PARFAIT** (J Toeroek) - contacted at the start.

**RACE 4: THIRSTY CAMEL CUP LAWN PARTY - 21 DEC AT MORPHETTVILLE MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres**

**HURRY HOME HARRY** (S Cahill) - approaching the 1500 metres was contacted by SCOUT'S HONOUR, which had its hindquarters turned.

**KHRUSHCHEV** (J Toeroek) - sprung a near fore plate on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SCOUT'S HONOUR** (J Maund) - approaching the 1500 metres shifted in and contacted the hindquarters of HURRY HOME HARRY and thereafter over-raced for some distance.

**ALIRIS** (J Potter) - awkward to begin. Shifted out at the start contacted KNAVESMIRE and thereafter raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

**FULL TILT** (C Caserta) - slow into stride and laid in, in the straight.

**KNAVESMIRE** (T Pannell) - awkward to begin, shifted in at the start and contacted ALIRIS. Laid out in the straight.

**ZAMERIC** (D Tourneur) - raced wide without cover from in the vicinity of the 900 metres.

**RACE 4: THIRSTY CAMEL CUP LAWN PARTY - 21 DEC AT MORPHETTVILLE MAIDEN PLATE**  
**- 1600 metres (Cont'd)**

**STELLA VITAE** (A Jordsjo) - proved difficult on leaving the mounting yard, refused to proceed to the barriers was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 5.29 pm. Trainer Mr T Doudle was advised the mare was required to perform to the satisfaction of the Stewards in either an Official Barrier Trial or an Approval to Race Jump out prior to presenting for a future race. Mr Doudle was also advised that the mare would have to present in a race-day saddle and proceed to the barriers from its tie-up stall unassisted.

**TEXAS LIL** (A K Chan) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 5: WHITE MARQUEE/ SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE THREE-YEAR-OLD & UP - 1200 metres**

**HABANERO** (R Hurdle) - laid in, in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres shifted in across the running of SHOP TIL I DROP, which was momentarily inconvenienced. Thereafter continued to lay in placing its rider at a disadvantage over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MALOUFF** (S. Cahill) - laid in, in the straight.

**ROBBERY** (K Bishop) - kicked at the start on arrival at the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. Awkward and slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

**ROCKWOOD BOY** (C Caserta) - accidentally dropped his whip approaching the 100 metres.

**SCARE CAMPAIGN** (A K Chan) - contacted at the start. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Held up for clear running approaching the entrance to the straight and on entering the straight was obliged to shift to the outside of MACSWEEN when awkwardly placed on the heels of that runner and thereafter laid in, in the straight.

**CALCUTTA** (T Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MACSWEEN** (J B Potter) - shifted out at the start and contacted SCARE CAMPAIGN. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

**SHOP TIL I DROP** (J. Kah) - approaching the 100 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by HABANERO, which laid in and shifted in and was obliged to alter course to that horse's outside to continue its run to the line.

**ELECTRUM** (E. Finnegan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since December 2017 and was passed fit to race.

**RACE 6: JIM & GLENDA SMYTH'S BIRTHDAY CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

**TAILGUNNER** (E Boyd) - raced very keenly in the early stages of the event. Approaching the 700 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of DOUBLE DENMAN shifted out and inconvenienced SIR GARFIELD. Shortly after the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve its position, contacted SIR GARFIELD but then became held up for a short distance when racing inside SIR GARFIELD and behind FROSTY GREY after being unable to move SIR GARFIELD wider on the track. Laid in, in the straight. Rider reported the gelding raced fiercely in the middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SIR GARFIELD** (R J Hurdle) - approaching the 700 metres was inconvenienced by TAILGUNNER, which shifted out when awkwardly placed on the heels of DOUBLE DENMAN. Thereafter, shortly after the entrance to the straight was contacted by TAILGUNNER as that horse attempted to shift out to improve.

**RACE 6: JIM & GLENDA SMYTH'S BIRTHDAY CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)**

**ST GEORGES VAULTS** (J Toeroek) - rider reported the gelding was reluctant when racing inside other runners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**FROSTY GREY** (A Jordsjo) - rider reported the mare felt lame in the off foreleg. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SHALL WE HOPE** (D Tourneur) - rider reported the gelding hung out during the event.

**MARTINIQUE** (J Kah) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

**RACE 7: PROPUNTERALERT.COM BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1050 metres**

**MISS LABELLE** (A K Chan) - awkward to begin, shifted in and contacted BRIMARVI VEHERO.

**BRIMARVI VEHERO** (J Toeroek) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted MISS LABELLE. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. Rider reported the gelding laid out from near the 600 metres. Rider spoken to regarding using his arm above shoulder height over the concluding stages.

**KNOTTED** (K Bishop) - awkward to begin.

**OGUNDE** (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**TIARA STAR** (J Kah) - contacted at the start. Laid in, in the straight. Taken wider from inside the 200 metres by BRIMARVI VEHERO, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SILENT ICE** (S Cahill) - rider reported the gelding travelled well in the early stages but when asked for an effort on entering the straight it became high in its racing action and did not finish the race off as expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GOUGERS** (R J Hurdle) - rider reported the gelding hung out rounding the home turn and failed to finish the event off as expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer Mr J. Hyam was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

**ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE)** (E Finnegan) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted TIARA STAR.

**VOD** (A Jordsjo) - scrambled in the float en route to the course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was reported to have an abrasion to its head and off hind hock but was passed fit to race.

**AMATIVE** (C Caserta) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr K. Sweeney, was advised that as this was the mare's first bi-lateral bleed AMATIVE would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

**RACE 8: IRON JACK BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP (HEAT 9 OF THE ALCOPOP SERIES) - 1600 metres**

**TARANTINO (NZ)** (S Cahill) - awkward to begin. Rider explained he formed a view during running that the gelding was galloped on behind and became concerned with its action. He added that in the straight the gelding failed to let down as expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SUPERVELOCE (NZ)** (J Kah) - had difficulty in obtaining clear running from approaching the entrance to the straight for a short distance. Shortly thereafter approaching the 200 metres shifted out to obtain clear running and when doing so contacted RIGHT AND READY.

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**RACE 8: IRON JACK BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP (HEAT 9 OF THE ALCOPOP SERIES)**  
- 1600 metres (Cont'd)

**DELLACQUA** (C Caserta) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Obligated to be checked near the 200 metres when its running was taken by RIGHT AND READY, which shifted out when insufficiently clear.

**SPRINGFIELD LEW** (E Boyd) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight.

**IN THE FAST LANE** (T Pannell) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**DOUBLESPEAK** (J Toeroek) - a late scratching by order of Stewards at 7.42 pm after it lost its off hind plate on arrival at the barriers. As the veterinary surgeon was not satisfied that the horse could be reshod, having regard for the condition of the horse's hoof, he considered it was unfit to start.

**JUST LIVE ON** (R J Hurdle) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event. Laid out over the concluding stages.

**LIZZIE LOUISE** (J Holder) - inconvenienced near the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of DELLACQUA, which had to be checked. Rider reported the mare felt awkward in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**VIKINGS REWARD** (A Jordsjo) - a late scratching at 8.15 am by order of Stewards after it was established that owing to technical difficulties experienced by the Trainer's Service Centre, Mr J. Hyam the Trainer of the gelding, was unable to scratch the horse as intended by scratching time.

**RIGHT AND READY** (S Fawke) - awkward to begin. Near the 250 metres shifted out taking the running of DELLACQUA when insufficiently clear resulting in DELLACQUA having to be checked to avoid RIGHT AND READY'S heels. Thereafter near the 200 metres was contacted by SUPERVELOCE (NZ), which shifted out. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Friday, 21 December and to conclude at midnight on Sunday, 30 December 2018 : a period of five meetings.

Correct weight was allowed to allow C. Caserta (DELLACQUA) placed fifth and Trainer Mr D. Jolly to view the vision in straight. After doing so, C. Caserta lodged a protest against S. Fawke being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference near the 250 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* the protest.
