RACE 1: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED HANDICAP - 2100 metres

USTINOV'S FURY (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OLYMPIC ACADEMY (S. Fawke) - contacted on jumping away. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

PERFECT RHYME (C. Caserta) - rider explained the mare had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however when placed under pressure at the entrance to the straight, failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOARING HIGH (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out brushing **OLYMPIC ACADEMY**. Rider explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however in the vicinity of the 600 metres when the pace quickened, was unable to maintain contact with the field despite his efforts and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: COOPERS DRY HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately six minutes.

NO JOY (J. Kah) - proved extremely difficult in proceeding to the barriers. Mr D. Jolly was advised a warning would be placed on the filly regarding it being reluctant in proceeding to the start. Mr Jolly explained the filly had been extremely difficult since the advice not to use products containing Altrenogest and that **NO JOY** would now be spelled. Stood flat-footed and was slow to begin.

FIRST DIAMOND (J. Holder) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

CALL ME HERBIE (A. Chan) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out rounding the home turn.

RACE 2: COOPERS DRY HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

SAPPHIRE MISS (E. Finnegan) - refused to proceed to the barriers. A late scratching by order of Stewards at 1.13 pm. Co- Trainer Mr G. Kent was advised the filly would be required to proceed to the barriers without delay in an Official Jump Out or Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 3: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

PRETTY GLASS (E. Finnegan) - shifted in shortly after the start onto WILLOCHRA. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RUBY SEA (T. Pannell) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WILLOCHRA (A. Chan) - inconvenienced on jumping away. Disappointed at the entrance to the straight when attempting a run to the outside of SAND CAT, which rolled out, resulting in WILLOCHRA having to alter course to obtain clear ground.

TOUCH (J. Potter) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr S. Oxlade was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

EQUIDAME (C. Caserta) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: TRIMBOLI SERVICES HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MARINA (S. Fawke) - had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 100 metres when the rider was obliged to alter course to the outside of MYSTICANO to obtain clear ground.

MYSTICANO (D. Tourneur) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

RACE 5: FESTIVAL HIRE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

KINGSON (D. Caboche) - raced fiercely in the early stages of the event.

GEORDIE'S SECOND (K. Bishop) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

OUTINTHESTREET (J. Kah) - held up from the entrance the straight until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

SIMPATICO (J. Potter) - improved onto the heels of OVER AND ABOVE in the vicinity of the 500 metres and had to be steadied momentarily.

RACE 6: BAROSSA WINES AT THE RACES - SAT JAN 12TH HANDICAP - 1700 metres

BILLET DOUX (A. Jordsjo) - rider explained it was not the instructions or her intention to lead the event, however the gelding had jumped away well, was strong on the bridle and had led by default.

CANNOT BE SERIOUS (NZ) (S. Cahill) - in the vicinity of the 350 metres shifted out and away from ELTIZAAM, which shifted out slightly, and became awkwardly placed and had to be checked off the heels of UNSCOPEABLE, which rolled in marginally. As a result CANNOT BE SERIOUS (NZ) lost its position and became awkward in its action for a number of strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: BAROSSA WINES AT THE RACES – SAT JAN 12TH HANDICAP - 1700 metres (Cont'd)

ELTIZAAM (D.Tourneur) – slow into stride. Rolled out marginally onto CANNOT BE SERIOS (NZ) in the vicinity of the 350 metres.

MARMAN (C. Caserta) – laid out rounding the home turn.

UNSCOPEABLE (S. Fawke) – rolled in marginally onto CANNOT EB SERIOS (NZ) in the vicinity of the 350 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr C. Bieg was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

SWEET KAIDER (D. Caboche) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7: PRINCE ALBERT HOTEL GAWLER HANDICAP – 1100 metres

WING SNIPPER (S. Cahill) – had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

TRIPLE DEEZ (D. Tourneur) – held up form the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

STREET LIFE (T. Pannell) – laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the winning post shifted out and contacted ALASKAN JADE, which shifted in at the same time. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KABINI (K. Bishop) – slow to begin. Approaching the finish was forced to take hold to avoid the heels of ALASKAN JAD, which shifted in.

ALASKAN JADE (J. Holder) – laid in under pressure in the straight. Approaching the finish shifted in when insufficiently clear of KABINI, which was forced to take hold to avoid the heels of ALASKAN JADE. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 16 December and to conclude at midnight on Saturday, 22 December 2018: a period of three meetings.

ANAMNESIS (D. Caboche) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 8: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL HANDICAP – 1500 metres

CHAPEL CITY (S. Cahill) – slow to begin.

TSARITSYN (D. Tourneur) – slow to begin.

WANTED BY ALL (D. Caboche) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer Mr C. Bieg was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

BOX ON COLLINS (J. Holder) – inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

DIAMOND TYCOON (C. Caserta) – laid out rounding the home turn.
