APPRENTICE JOCKEYS

OFFICIAL POLICY

In the event an Apprentice Jockey outrides his/her claim or has a claim reduced at a race meeting, an owner, trainer or their authorized representative of a runner for which that Apprentice has been declared, may make an application to replace the Apprentice due to the Apprentice's claim changing.

Each application should be considered on its own merit, however Stewards should determine that the connections sought an undertaking that the Apprentice would take his claim or part thereof.

Consideration must also be given to what replacement options are available to connections.

Any application for a winning percentage, or a losing fee, should be determined by the Stewards on its merit.

No action should be taken against an Apprentice in these circumstances.
