

REINSTATEMENT OF FIRST TIME BLEEDER OFFICIAL POLICY

1. The Trainer should ring the Stewards office and confirm that a Steward will be available to observe the horse gallop.
2. A Steward will attend track work as arranged.
3. The Trainer will present the horse and Document of Description.
4. The Steward will inform the Trainer and the Rider of our requirements that:
 - a) the horse works a strong 1000 metres, and
 - b) is ridden under pressure (*hands and heels*) over the concluding 200 metres.
5. The Steward will observe the horse from a position in the vicinity of the winning post and must be satisfied that the horse has done the work required.
6. The Steward will observe the horse for a short period after the gallop.
7. The Steward will endorse the Document of Description.
8. The Stewards will notify the Registrar and update the system.
