

Rule ARR.88 states –

*“Riders may use spurs provided they are blunt and of a type approved by the Stewards.”*

It has come to notice that spurs being used within the State may have been altered from the manufacturers dimensions, which have been “approved by the Stewards”.

Riders shall be provided with notice that after 1 March 2008 only spurs “approved by the Stewards” will be permitted to be used in South Australia.

Only spurs with an undistorted heel fitting with the spur extending at 90° from the back of the heel and which is blunt, shall be “approved by the Stewards”.

From 1 March 2008 all spurs not properly aligned will be confiscated and the rider concerned may be penalised.
