

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse
by the Penola Racing Club on Sunday, 21 April 2019

Stewards: J. Adams (A/Chairman), K. Lemay-Robbins (MT) & A. Streckbein (HT) (Cadet Stewards), J. Forster (F) (Deputy Steward), Dr D. Goulding (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Downgraded at 1.20 pm to a Soft 5 retrospective to Race 3
(Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RAIL: True

WEATHER: Showers

RACE 1: ADRIAN THOMAS INDUSTRIAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

DR HOMER (S. Fawke) - held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until inside the 200 metres. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

READY DEAL (C. Jones) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MISS CAVENDISH (R. Clark) - stood flat-footed as the start was affected and as a result was slow to begin. Trainer Mr P. Young was advised the mare would be required to jump to the satisfaction of the Stewards in an Official Trial or/and Official Jump Out prior to presenting for a future race.

REVOLUTION BABY (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SECRET IS SAFE (E. Boyd) - held up for clear running from the 400 metres until inside the 200 metres. Rider stated his mount was under pressure from the vicinity of the 600 metres and ran to line in a disappointing manner.

RACE 2: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

HANLON TIGER (K. Bishop) - slow to begin. Hung out from the vicinity of the 500 metres and continued to hang out in the straight.

HASTA LA DEVEGA (D. Tourneur) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in the past 12 months and passed fit to race.

NETRA'S BOY (S. Payne) - attempted to buck shortly after jumping away. Trainer Mr J. Brooks was advised the gelding would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUBY QUE (J. Maund) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

SAHARA RIVER (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres blundered for no apparent reason.

SURREALNESS (K. Lau) - slow to begin. Rider stated his mount failed to respond to his riding at any stages of the event. Trainer Mrs S. Murphy was advised the filly would be required to trial competitively to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

SANDHILL FLASH (K. Bishop) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: PRINCE OF WALES HOTEL/MOTEL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1700 metres

HASTA LA SPEC (D. Tourneur) - laid in from the vicinity of the 400 metres and continued to lay in for the remainder of the straight.

RACE 5: OMNIZAR BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

RHYTHMATIC (D. Tourneur) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Rider reported his mount hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BRONSKI (J. Huxtable) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: WATTLE RANGE COUNCIL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

THE OTHER GUY (R. Clark) - began awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was disappointed for a narrow run between **TAKEMEHOMEMISTER** and **FUGITIVE**. As a result was awkwardly placed on the heels of **FUGITIVE** for a number of strides and was obliged to shift wider in an attempt to improve into clear running.

SHE'S ALL POWER (S. Logan) - began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported her saddle slipped in the vicinity of the 400 metres and as a result lost the use of both irons, placing her at a disadvantage and was unable to ride her mount out over any stage over the concluding stages.

FUGITIVE (S. Fawke) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in the past 12 months and passed fit to race.

RACE 7: KATNOOK ESTATE PENOLA CUP - 2100 metres

FLOW METER (S. Fawke) - held up for clear running in the vicinity of the 400 metres to inside the 300 metres.

ZEBRINZ (J. Huxtable) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100. Rider reported his mount weakened noticeably on entering the home straight. He became concerned with the gelding's action and as a result, he did not place his mount under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA THOMAS (D. Tourneur) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

GO WALLY (G. Lo) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: THOMAS DEGARIS & CLARKSON BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

PEWTER (J. Maund) - tightened for room shortly after jumping away by **STAGHORN**, which rolled out. Held up for clear running in the vicinity of the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

RACE 8: THOMAS DEGARIS & CLARKSON BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1300 metres (Cont'd)

SCHOOLWORK (J. Huxtable) - tightened for room shortly after jumping away by STAGHORN, which rolled out.

LOCKTOBA ROCKS (S. Payne) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

STAGHORN (R. Clark) - shifted out shortly after jumping away taking STRATEDIC SPICE out onto SCHOOLWORK, which was taken out onto PEWTER, which was hampered. Rider was reminded of her obligations to stop and straighten her mounts when they shift ground in future. Held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 300 metres until approaching the 100 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

STRATEGIC SPICE (G. Lo) - tightened for room shortly after jumping away by STAGHORN, which rolled out. Held up for clear running in the vicinity of the 300 metres and was obliged to shift in to improve into clear running.
