Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler and Barossa Jockey Club on Sunday, 12 May 2019

TRACK: Soft 6 (Moist but not a badly effected track)

RAIL: Out 5 metres 800 metres to 400 metres, 2 metres remainder. Sectional 606 metres

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 1: HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

HAYAKU MISS (J. Chau) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out and became awkwardly placed on the heels of DEXTINY for a short distance.

ISSARA (P. Gatt) - slow to begin. Hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: KINGSFORD HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 2118 metres

SHIRLEY'S EAGLE (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 500 metres until shortly after the entrance to the straight. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MATAS (S. Fawke) - slow into stride.

NORMAN PRINCESS (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and as a result shifted out to a three wide line in the vicinity of the 1500 metres and raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: COOPERS / SABOIS PLUS BENCHMARK 75 HANDICAP - 2118 metres

EXALTED LIGHTNING (R. Clark) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: COOPERS / SABOIS PLUS BENCHMARK 75 HANDICAP - 2118 metres (Cont'd)

EPERDUMENT (D. Tourneur) - inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

SHAKOPEE (GB) (S. Logan) - hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr G. Young was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 4: SA BOOKMAKERS ASSOCIATION / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1514 metres

GRASSY KNOLL (S. Fawke) - hung out throughout the event.

HINDLEY STREET (S. Cahill) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported the gelding slipped on jumping away and therefore he was unable to lead as he intended.

RAPID BAY (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly. Shortly after the start, when entering the course proper from the 1500 metre chute, shifted in abruptly, inside the line of the running rail and lost several lengths when being corrected. Held up for clear running from the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight.

VACANT BLOCK (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

LYRICKIN'S DREAM (P. Gatt) - shortly after the start shifted in behind runners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: HOLDFAST INSURANCE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

FRANK GOES BOOM (S. Price) - slow to begin.

IT'S MAGIC (K. Lau) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LUCKY BREAK (J. Toeroek) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: GOLDIN FARMS BAROSSA CUP MAY 22ND CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1100 metres

PANZER PRINCESS (A. Jordsjo) - hung out rounding the home turn.

TOFFEE BELL (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped TOMAHAWK LAD.

TASTE OF DIAMONDS (D. Tourneur) - approaching the 600 metres dipped for no apparent reason.

TOMAHAWK LAD (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped TOFFEE BELL. Weakened noticeably from approaching the 200 metres. Rider reported the gelding was disappointing in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PERFEK (S. Logan) - approaching the 800 metres shifted in onto TOFFEE BELL and as a result had its hindquarters turned.

RACE 7: GOLDIN FARMS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1514 metres

BOHEMIAN FOREST (J. Holder) - inside the 800 metres bumped with CAVALRY GOLD, which rolled out.

RACE 7: GOLDIN FARMS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1514 metres (Cont'd)

SNOWBROOK (D. Tourneur) - in the vicinity of the 1100 metres rolled in onto CAVALRY GOLD, which was momentarily inconvenienced. At the entrance to the straight brushed with UNSCOPEABLE on a number of occasions

UNSCOPEABLE (J. Toeroek) - approaching the 800 metres rolled out. At the entrance to the straight, brushed with SNOWBROOK on a number of occasions.

CAVALRY GOLD (J. Maund) - inside the 1100 metres was momentarily inconvenienced as SNOWBROOK rolled in. Approaching the 800 metres was inconvenienced when racing keenly as UNSCOPEABLE rolled out. Inside the 800 metres, when racing keenly, became awkward on the heels of UNSCOPEABLE and rolled out bumping BOHEMIAN FOREST.

JARRVIS (E. Boyd) - slow into stride.

RACE 8: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

OH MO (D. Tourneur) - held up for clear running from the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres when racing between DOCTOR DOOLITTLE and MISS INSOMNIA. Shortly after, shifted out and bumped with MISS INSOMNIA on a number of occasions.

DOCTOR DOOLITTLE (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOCIAL MEDIA (K. Bishop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CRYSTAL MOMENT (K. Lau) - jumped away very awkwardly.

TURF TAPPER (S. Logan) - knuckled on jumping away.

FABULOUS FLIPPER (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS INSOMNIA (A. Jordsjo) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres bumped with OH MO on a number of occasions.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Trainer Ms N. Bruggemann and Jockey A. Jordsjo (MISS INSOMNIA) to view the vision in the straight before deciding not to lodge an objection.
