

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse
by the Strathalbyn Racing Club on Sunday, 19 May 2019

Stewards: J. Adams (A/Chairman), M. Williams (M) & A. Milne (F) (Stewards), K. Lemay-Robbins (HT) (Cadet Steward) E. Tickner, & H. Matthews (Deputy Stewards), Dr P. Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Downgraded to a Soft 5 @ 12.33 pm retrospective to Race 1 (Track with reasonable amount of give in it)
Downgraded to a Soft 6 @ 2.27 pm retrospective to Race 4 (Moist but not a badly affected track)
Downgraded to a Soft 7 @ 3.02 pm retrospective to Race 5 (Rain affected track that will chop out)
Downgraded to a Heavy 8 @ 3.39 pm retrospective to Race 6 (Rain affected track that horses will get into)
Downgraded to a Heavy 9 @ 4.47 pm retrospective to Race 8 (Wet track getting into a squelchy area)

RAIL: Out 3 metres 1350 metres to 240 metres, true to winning post, out 2 metres back to 1350 metres.

WEATHER: Overcast/Showers

RACE 1: PHILMAC / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

SEAS THE HOST (C. Lions) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 1300 metres shifted out while over-racing when insufficiently clear of **ULTIMATE REALITY**. Rider was reminded of her obligations to be clear when shifting ground in future.

ULTIMATE REALITY (S. Cahill) - in the vicinity of the 1300 metres was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of **SEAS THE HOST**, which shifted out when insufficiently clear. In the vicinity of the 500 metres was momentarily inconvenienced and had to be steadied after **GRINZINGER CHARGER** (NZ) shifted out and **RETURN THE FAVOUR** laid in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr S. Cahill, was advised that as this was the first first bi-lateral bleed **ULTIMATE REALITY** would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

GRINZINGER CHARGER (NZ) (C. Jones) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was bumped on a number of occasions by **RETURN THE FAVOUR**, which shifted in despite the efforts of its rider.

RETURN THE FAVOUR (J. Toeroek) - slow to begin. Laid in throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres laid in despite the efforts of its rider bumping **GRINZINGER CHARGER** (NZ) on a number of occasions.

RACE 2: DAVET / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

MISS FORBIDDEN (S. Logan) - slow into stride.

RACE 2: DAVET / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (cont'd)

CHAPPETTE (J. Toeroek) - rider reported his mount raced greenly throughout the event.

HELPENY (K. Cowan) - held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

QUEEN'S SONG (T. Pannell) - when questioned regarding the performance of the filly rider reported his mount travelled well throughout the event, was trapped three wide for the majority of the event but in the vicinity of the 400 metres **SASSY MANEUVER** was able to improve into his inside pushing him in a four-wide position. He added he was impressed with his mounts finishing efforts and would take benefit from today's run.

RACE 3: ORANGE PUMPS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

TWIN CARBS (C. Jones) - slow to begin.

AZDAJA (R. Clark) - began awkwardly, shifted in contacting **CHARMIST**.

CHARMIST (T. Pannell) - bumped on jumping away.

GOOD TIME MADAM (D. Tourneur) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 300 metres.

SUNNY GREEN (E. Boyd) - Trainer advised Stewards of a change in tactics in that he would instruct his rider to be more forward in today's event. Settled on pace.

RACE 4: DAISH IRRIGATION / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 63 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

CONCONI (R. Clark) - slow to begin.

ATOMIC LOKADE (A. Jordsjo) - over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

SAPPHIRE MISS (G. Lo) - a late scratching at 1.23 pm on veterinary advice as it was lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr W. Clarcken was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

ANGEL'S WISH (K. Lau) - laid out in the vicinity of the 800 metres and continued to lay out for the remainder of the event.

RACE 5: GRUNDFOS / SABOIS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE - 2065 metres

KING ARTHUR (J. Maund) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

LORD GREYSON (S. Fawke) - in the vicinity of the 1900 metres was obliged to be restrained to avoid the heels of **GARIFULLINA** (NZ), which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Over raced in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OURKHANI (J. Toeroek) - laid in and raced greenly throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 1900 metres, shifted in despite the efforts of its rider hampering **DAYS GO BY** (FR).

DAYS GO BY (FR) (C. Jones) - in the vicinity of the 1900 metres was obliged to be restrained to avoid the heels of **GARIFULLINA** (NZ), which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Shortly after had to be restrained again to avoid the heels of **OURKHANI**, which shifted in to despite the efforts of its rider.

RACE 5: GRUNDFOS / SABOIS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE - 2065 metres (Cont'd)

GARIFULLINA (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - in the vicinity of the 1900 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of DAYS GO BY (FR) and continued to shift in when insufficiently clear of LORD GREYSON. Rider was severely reprimanded.

MATAS (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: AAP VALVES AND FITTINGS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

COLESBERG (S. Cahill) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

I'M BULLETPROOF (T. Pannell) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until inside the 300 metres.

CONTAINMENT (J. Holder) - rider accidentally dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 150 metres.

ASHADY HUSSY (J. Toeroek) - held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

MADNESS INVALENCIA (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

TURF TAPPER (S. Logan) - dislodged its rider en route to the barriers before being recaptured. Rider was examined by First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.

RACE 7: ADELAIDE BELT AND HOSE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

BAJAN (P. Gatt) - slow to begin.

THANASI (J. Holder) - began awkwardly, shifted in contacted KING RED. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN (R. Hurdle) - began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

KING RED (T. Pannell) - contacted on jumping away.

REGAL EAGLE (J. Toeroek) - rider stated in his opinion the gelding failed to handle the heavy track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRYKER FORTUNE (A. Jordsjo) - laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

SELDOM HOME (C. Lions) - slow to begin. Rider was reprimanded under AR132(6)(c) for using her whip out of contention.

RACE 8: TEAM POLY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

SAVVY DRESSER (NZ) (S. Cahill) - rider reported his mount made respiratory noises and as a result elected to not place his mount under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IGITUR (D. Tourneur) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: TEAM POLY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres (Cont'd)

CAVALRY GOLD (R. Clark) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

FISH BONES FRY (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

HOFF'S OFF (J. Toeroek) - dislodged its rider en route to the barriers. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfil his engagement. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

STRATEGIC SPICE (G. Lo) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED JENNI (S. Logan) - slow to begin.
