STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORTReport on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse
by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 15 December 2019

RACE 1: HR DRILLING BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 12000 metres

COMMANDING DIVA (J. Potter) - slow into stride. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

AKERBOY (L. Neindorf) - hung out rounding the home turn.

On return to scale it was established that the scales had malfunctioned and could not be repaired. Consequently riders were not able to be weighed in. Stewards noted that all riders weighed out correctly for this event. Stewards also viewed the video footage of the race and found no evidence of any rider losing any gear/weight during the event. Acting under the provisions of AR208(3)(b) correct weight was declared as Stewards were of the opinion that all riders had carried their correct weight in the race.

A replacement set of scales was subsequently sourced and used for the remainder of the meeting.

RACE 2: FARMERS LEAP / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to start at 1.42 pm due to the malfunction of the scales in Race 1.

CHAMPERS ON ICE (R. Hurdle) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was kicked by another runner on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race. Rounding the home turn was eased out of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind leg. Co-Trainer, Mr J. Bates, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start. First aid administered.

O'MIZZNA (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

RACE 3: IRON JACK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1550 metres

LITHOSPHERE (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin and tailed the field throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr C. Stewart was advised the gelding would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

OLIVE GROVE (G. Lo) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 500 metres shifted out to improve its position inconveniencing SANDHILL HUSTLE, which was taken wider. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

SANDHILL HUSTLE (J. Lorensini) - approaching the 500 metres was inconvenienced when taken wider on the track.

AL MA BELLE (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SASSY RAIDER (J. Potter) - slow to begin.

RACE 4: WOOLSHED INN BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

HASTA LA FIORENTE (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

SHAKOPEE (GB) (J. Potter) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Reminded of his obligations under AR132(40)(6)(b) for using his whip above shoulder height.

RACE 5: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1100 metres

ROSE TIARA (D. Tourneur) - at the entrance to the straight was momentarily inconvenienced when SHALL WE HOPE shifted out marginally and ROCKSTAR RANGA shifted in marginally.

SHALL WE HOPE (S. Fawke) - at the entrance to the straight shifted out marginally, momentarily inconveniencing ROSE TIARA.

RASUMADOLE (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin.

ROCKSTAR RANGA (T. Voorham) - at the entrance to the home straight shifted in marginally momentarily inconveniencing ROSE TIARA.

VEIN CHOICE (K. Bishop) - approaching the 600 metres hung out and raced keenly for a short distance when being restrained off heels.

Correct weight was delayed to allow D. Tourneur (ROSE TIARA) placed sixth, to view the official vision. After doing so lodged an objection against SHALL WE HOPE (S. Fawke) placed second, alleging interference at the entrance to the home straight. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* the protest.

RACE 6: WICKHAM FLOWER BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1550 metres

TERRITORY TITAN (J. Lorensini) - pulled hard and raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BIG CALL (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GUEST LIST (J. Chau) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 7: DOAN PHARMACIES BORDERTOWN CUP - 2000 metres

PASS THE GLASS (P. Gatt) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 8: THIRSTY CAMEL BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

DR DAPPER (J. Chau) - slow to begin.

KODAKHAN (J. Lorensini) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping BURN THE TURF.

JUST CHIPPING AWAY (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

WARATAH GIRL (K. Bishop) - slow to begin.

BURN THE TURF (D. Tourneur) - bumped on jumping away when KODAKHAN jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.
