Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse  
by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 3 May 2020

**RACE 1: WICKHAM FLOWER / SABOIS MAIDEN/ CLASS 1 PLATE - 2000 Metres**

**KARAOKE EXPRESS** (S. Logan) - approaching the 400 metres was tightened onto GONDOLIER and bumped with PROVOCATIVE MAN on a number of occasion as that gelding was taken in by HAPPY ATOM, which laid in.

**BAD MOON RISING** (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting HALLO POPPET. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

**MALAKEED** (K. Zechner) - on jumping away shifted out onto PROVOCATIVE MAN, which lost its position. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Shortly after the winning post was buffeted between STEELCAPSTILETTOS and CEALLACH for a number of strides. Hung in under pressure in the straight.

**HAPPY ATOM** (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres commenced to make its run wide around the field without cover. Approaching the 400 metres laid in and contacted PROVOCATIVE MAN, which was taken in and tightened onto KARAOKE EXPRESS. Inclined to lay in for the remainder of the event.

**PROVOCATIVE MAN** (J. Potter) - lost its position on jumping away as MALAKEED shifted out. Hung in under pressure in the straight.

**HALLO POPPET** (D. Tourneur) - prior to the event Trainer Mr P. Hardacre advised Stewards that he would instruct his rider to be neutral out of the barriers due to the wide barrier draw. Settled back. On jumping away contacted BAD MOON RISING.

**CEALLACH** (M. Collett) - rider reminded of her obligations under AR132(6)(c) in using her whip when her mount is out of contention.

**RACE 2: TATIARA CARPET CLEANING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

### **RACE 2: TATIARA CARPET CLEANING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)**

**BADOS** (P. Gatt) - on jumping away bumped with GO BOO BOO.

**SANDHILL MAX** (S. Fawke) - slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 800 metres bumped with GO BOO BOO, which shifted in and away from another runner.

**JUSTEDEE** (G. Cartwright) - on jumping away shifted in and bumped MISS CATASTROPHI.

**MY MISTER BROOKS** (E. Boyd) - on jumping away shifted out and bumped MISS CATASTROPHI. Hung out throughout the event and proved very difficult for the rider to control. Trainer Mr J. MacMillan advised the gelding would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump out prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**WINTER HARBOUR** (J. Maund) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres shifted in onto MISS CATASTROPHI, which was looking to improve to the inside of that gelding and was obliged to shift out and alter course. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a).

**GO BOO BOO** (K. Bishop) - bumped with BADOS on jumping away. Approaching the 800 metres shifted in and away from SHAKAMBER and bumped SANDHILL MAX. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was disappointed for a run to the inside of JUSTEDEE and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running. At the finish line was obliged to ease when awkwardly placed on the heels of WINTER HARBOUR.

**MISS CATASTROPHI** (J. Potter) - on jumping away bumped with JUSTEDEE, which shifted in. In the vicinity of the 400 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of MY MISTER BROOKS for a number of strides. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to alter course to the outside of WINTER HARBOUR, which laid in.

**ISA SECRET** (D. Tourneur) - fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.

### **RACE 3: IRON JACK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

**CORAGGIO** (C. Jones) - tightened for room shortly after the start and unable to improve its position when racing between HALAYR DREAM and GOLDEN INSIGHT. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

**DR CHOCCY** (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly and got its head up. Rider reported the gelding hung out throughout the event and did not feel comfortable in its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**FENCELINE** (D. Tourneur) - rider reported it was his intention to lead in the event, however after encouraging the gelding in the early stages failed to respond to his riding and therefore could not obtain a position closer to the lead. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**YADSEMOD** (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

**BLACK CHEVAL** (S. Cahill) - held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

**FINAL CHANCE** (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly.

**GOLDEN INSIGHT** (E. Boyd) - proved difficult to load. Trainer Mr J. MacMillan was advised a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners.

**RACE 3: IRON JACK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)**

**WURLIES LASTCHANCE** (T. Voorham) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

**RACE 4: DOAN PHARMACIES BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

**RHYTHMATIC** (J. Opperman) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**BY THE POUND** (C. Jones) - proved difficult to load. Trainer Ms K. Mooney was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding. Reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

**EQUUS D'ORO** (L. Neindorf) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**STRAGUN** (M. Collett) - held up for a short distance from shortly after the entrance to the straight when racing between **BY THE POUND** and **RIBS**.

**EXALTED LAURETTA** (J. Maund) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

**RACE 5: FINNS FINE FOODS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres**

**REDEEKA** (Jacob Opperman) - Trainer Mr Jamie Opperman advised Stewards prior to the event that he would instruct his rider to be more forward in today's event. Settled mid to back. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres was tightened between **SIRIUS JOURNEY** and **MR RANGER** and was obliged to be eased. Held up for clear running at the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 250 metres.

**KLIPPEN** (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 200 metres bumped with **MR RANGER**.

**MR RANGER** (K. Crowther) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres rolled out and brushed with **KLIPPEN**.

**REBEL TANTRUM** (J. Potter) - slow to begin losing many lengths. In the vicinity of the 800 metres, when being restrained, took charge of its rider and was obliged to shift out in the vicinity of the 700 metres and in doing so shifted out onto **MISS MOSH**, which was obliged to be eased. From that point on, hung out for the remainder of the event and proved very difficult for the rider to ride. Mrs S. Kotz was advised the gelding would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump out prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MISS MOSH** (P. Gatt) - in the vicinity of the 700 metres was obliged to be eased as **REBEL TANTRUM** shifted out. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

**HABANERO** (S. Cahill) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

**MAGIC NAME** (M. Collett) - rider reported the gelding hung in throughout the event.

**RACE 6: FINNS FINE FOODS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres**

**JAAMINT** (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly.

**SCARFACE CURIO** (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

**NOSTROVIA** (D. Tourneur) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced since September 2018 and passed fit to race.

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#### **RACE 6: FINNS FINE FOODS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)**

**WATCH DAT STINGER** (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**CANIDAE** (K. Zechner) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

**GEORGINA GOLD** (J. Potter) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

**PRIME SUSPECT** (S. Fawke) - hung out throughout the event.

#### **RACE 7: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres**

**LANCASTER SOUND** (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. In the vicinity of the 400 metres clipped the heels of AL KAPHERO, which broke down and unbalanced its rider for several strides and as result lost ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame off hind leg. Trainer, Ms S. Murphy, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

**RANGER FRANK** (S. Cahill) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

**DR DEE DEE** (K. Crowther) - lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto MAGICHELL, which shifted in and LANCASTER SOUND, which shifted out.

**MAGICHELL** (L. Halliday) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in onto DR DEE DEE, which lost its position. In the vicinity of the 800 metres, when being restrained, raced keenly when tightened to the inside of AL KAPHERO. In the vicinity of the 500 metres became tight to the inside of AL KAPHERO for a short distance. In the vicinity of the 400 metres was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of AL KAPHERO, which broke down. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**AL KAPHERO** (S. Logan) - re-saddled at the start. Approaching the 400 metres blundered in its action and broke down. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a fracture to the near fore shoulder and was humanely euthanised.

**THE PUBLIKIN** (P. Gatt) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

#### **RACE 8: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres**

The start of this event was rescheduled to 4.19 pm owing to a delay experienced in the previous event in relation to AL KAPHERO.

**BASSONS** (R. Hurdle) - slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was taken wider by CHARMIST.

**SIERRA MOON** (C. Jones) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from in the vicinity of the 100 metres until the finish.

**SPOTAKOVA** (J. Maund) - held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 50 metres until the finish.

**BULLET KID** (T. Voorham) - Trainer Mr L. Cadzow advised Stewards prior to the event that he would instruct his rider to attempt to lead due to the wide barrier draw. Settled in the lead.

**CHARMIST** (E. Boyd) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted out taking BASSONS wider.

**RACE 8: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres (Cont'd)**

STRATEGIC SPICE (L. Neindorf) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

CONNERMARA ROSE (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.
