**RACE 1: 2019/20 PREMIERSHIP TRAINER GRANT YOUNG / SABOIS ENTIRES & GELDINGS
MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres**

EAGLE'S WINGS (K. Crowther) - knuckled on jumping away.

ILLUSION DATE (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres became tightened onto **WINTER HARBOUR** and was held up for a short distance when racing to the inside of **OOLONG GAZE**, which was inclined to hang in.

OOLONG GAZE (B. Vorster) - hung in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in onto **ILLUSION DATE (NZ)**, which was tightened onto **WINTER HARBOUR**. Shortly after continued to shift in and as a result **WINTER HARBOUR** was inconvenienced.

SNIP OF TIME (S. So) - slow to begin.

WINTER HARBOUR (D. Caboche) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was inconvenienced as **OOLONG GAZE**, which was hanging in, shifted in. When questioned in relation to the gelding's performance, rider stated **WINTER HARBOUR** travelled well during the event, however when asked for an effort from the entrance to the straight, failed to let down and was disappointing in its efforts to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 2: 2019/20 PREMIERSHIP JOCKEY TODD PANNELL / SABOIS MARES MAIDEN PLATE -
1100 Metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

RACE 2: 2019/20 PREMIERSHIP JOCKEY TODD PANNELL / SABOIS MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

ARCTIC FLORA (J. Holder) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until approaching the 200 metres when racing between **ELECTRUM** and **TIME FLIES BY** and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

ELECTRUM (T. Voorham) - shortly after the start dipped. Laid out over the concluding stages and in the vicinity of the 50 metres rolled out onto **TIME FLIES BY**.

GARDEN PARTY (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly. Over raced in the early and middle stages of the event and when being restrained got its head up on a number of occasions. Laid in under pressure over the final 100 metres until the finish. Inside the 100 metres became awkward on the heels of **TIME FLIES BY**, which rolled out when being corrected.

KRUPTONITE (S. So) - shortly after the start was hampered and lost its position when bumped with **KUMO SUN**.

KUMO SUN (K. Crowther) - lost its off hind plate during the event. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped **ZEGRESTO**. Shortly after rolled out and bumped **KRUPTONITE** and as a result **KUMO SUN'S** hindquarters were turned in. Held up for clear running for a short distance from shortly after the entrance to the straight when racing between **ZEGRESTO** and **AFTER YOU**.

MUG'S GAME (J. Maund) - raced greenly throughout the event.

TIME FLIES BY (J. Toeroek) - hung in under pressure in the straight and inside the 200 metres became awkward on the heels of **ELECTRUM**. Inside the 100 metres rolled out when being corrected. In the vicinity of the 50 metres, when inclined to lay in, was inconvenienced as **ELECTRUM** rolled out.

ZEGRESTO (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped **KUMO SUN**. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. When questioned in relation to the mare's performance, the rider explained that **ZEGRESTO** raced on the wrong leg throughout the event and proved difficult for him to ride in an attempt to correct the horse's action. Once placed under pressure in the straight, the mare failed to let down and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: ATKINS PHOTOGRAPHY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 Metres

FOLLOW THE PROMPTS (J. Potter) - on arrival at the barriers was required to have its bridle readjusted. Rider reported the gelding hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KNEE SLAPPER (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Hung out from in the vicinity of the 600 metres until the finish.

CASINO SEVENTEEN (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

DASH TO COURT (J. Holder) - following the declaration of acceptances Trainer Mr C. Bieg made a gear application to add blinkers to the gelding's race gear. Stewards accepted this request and acting under AR206(2) fined Mr Bieg \$200. When questioned in relation to the gelding's performance, rider reported that he could offer no explanation but when asked for an effort in the vicinity of the 300 metres, the gelding failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HENRY THE BRUCE (J. Maund) - required to be resaddled on arrival at the barriers.

SMART VISION (M. Vassallo) - shortly after the start, from its wide barrier, shifted in to obtain cover.

RACE 3: ATKINS PHOTOGRAPHY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 Metres (Cont'd)

WIN GOLD (E. Boyd) - dipped in the vicinity of the 400 metres and from that point on weakened out of the event. Rider explained in relation to the mare's performance that it may not have handled today's track conditions and did not feel comfortable in its action when asked for an effort approaching the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BIARCHI (K. Crowther) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

BRIABELLA (M. Collett) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: BE BUSHFIRE READY LABOUR DAY CUP BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 3000 Metres

LINE DANCER (K. Zechner) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had raced on Wednesday, 30 September 2020 at Murray Bridge and passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MATAS (J. Eaton) - in the vicinity of the 1100 metres shifted out wide and commenced its run forward and settled outside the leader.

MAGUS MAN (S. So) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

KARAOKE EXPRESS (S. Logan) - approaching the crossing at the 1700 metres, shifted out and as a result the rider became awkward in her saddle for a number of strides.

FORAOISE (A. Jordsjo) - in the vicinity of the 500 metres was hampered when tightened onto **DROP THE ORANGE** as **ROUGH BEAUTY** rolled in.

ROUGH BEAUTY (J. Maund) - from its wide barrier shifted in to obtain cover. In the vicinity of the 500 metres rolled in onto **FORAOISE**, which was hampered when tightened onto **DROP THE ORANGE**. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported the mare made abnormal respiratory noises during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: BARASTOC HORSE FEEDS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

JACK'S A CRACKER (S. So) - rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that the gelding may not have handled today's conditions and was disappointing in its efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLYING PIERRO (J. Toeroek) - from its wide barrier shifted in to obtain cover. In the vicinity of the 200 metres brushed with **LITTLEBITFUNNY**, which was laying out and shifted out.

HAHNDORF (J. Opperman) - hung out from rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LORD ROSENTHAL (D. Tourneur) - inside the 600 metres weakened from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LITTLEBITFUNNY (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 1400 metres raced fiercely until near the 1200 metres. Laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres brushed with **FLYING PIERRO**.

RACE 6: CORNERSTONE STUD RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

RACE 6: CORNERSTONE STUD RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

GENERAL MINT (J. Toeroek) - obliged to be re-saddled on arrival at the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CANIDAE (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out onto L'AMARYBELLE. Inside the 800 metres became awkward on the heels and was obliged to be restrained as the pace was eased slightly.

JUST JILTED (J. Potter) - approaching the 800 metres commenced to race keenly and get its head up shortly after KHANI STAR shifted in. Inside the 100 metres commenced to lay in. Rider also dropped his left rein inside the 100 metres and when being corrected, dropped his right rein, he was able to regain both reins prior to the winning post.

JETTA JAE (R. Hurdle) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres rolled in onto NEWBAY FLYER (NZ).

L'AMARYBELLE (J. Opperman) - on jumping away was crowded between KHANI STAR and CANIDAE, which shifted out. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.

DEXSTRA (D. Stra) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

ENVYEM (D. Tourneur) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in to obtain cover. Approaching the 900 metres rolled out slightly onto NEWBAY FLYER (NZ).

ZOUSTORM (D. Tootell) - jumped away very awkwardly. Inside the 800 metres became awkward on the heels and was obliged to be restrained as the pace eased slightly. In the vicinity of the 600 metres became awkward on the heels and was obliged to be restrained. Held up for clear running from the 500 metres until inside the 400 metres.

KHANI STAR (E. Boyd) - approaching the 800 metres shifted in and shortly after JUST JILTED commenced to over-race and was obliged to be steadied.

NEWBAY FLYER (NZ) (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in to obtain cover. In the vicinity of the 900 metres when over-racing, clipped the heels, dipped and became awkward for a short distance as JETTA JAE rolled in and ENVYEM rolled out.

RACE 7: HYLAND SPORTSWEAR BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

RAKOVSKY (NZ) (S. So) - slow to begin.

DON'T DISMISS (D. Stra) - on jumping away bumped with TATTIES, which shifted out.

MALAKEED (S. Fawke) - weakened from in the vicinity of the 400 metres. Rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BELEURA DEMON (J. Holder) - at the entrance to the straight was taken out by NOSTROVIA, which was taken out by HOLY SANGRIA. Lost its near for plate during the event.

HOLY SANGRIA (S. Logan) - over raced in the early and middle stages of the event. At the entrance to the straight, shifted out taking NOSTROVIA and BELEURA DEMON wider. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

NOSTROVIA (K. Zechner) - at the entrance to the straight was taken out by HOLY SANGRIA. Shortly after was obliged to be eased and shifted in to obtain clear running.

RACE 7: HYLAND SPORTSWEAR BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres (Cont'd)

COOL DESERT (D. Tootell) - rider reported he had concerns with the mare's action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abnormal upper respiratory noise. Trainer Mr D. Tootell (Snr) was advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the mare's for a future trial or race.

TATTIES (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly and bumped DON'T DISMISS. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

STRYKE IN STYLE (S. Logan) - shortly after the entrance to the straight brushed with DETENTORE (NZ), which was taken out.

DETENTORE (NZ) (D. Tootell) - appeared to have blood in it near side nostril on arrival on course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and revealed a small cut to the inside of the gelding's nostril and passed fit to race. In the vicinity of the 700 metres rolled in onto AUSSIE JACK, which was obliged to be eased when tightened onto GALCRUM. Shortly after the entrance to the straight was taken wider by SASSY MANEUVER and brushed with STRYKE IN STYLE.

GALCRUM (J. Maund) - weakened from in the vicinity of the 300 metres, was restrained and failed to finish the event. On return to scale rider expressed concern with the mare's action and for this reason he elected to retire his mount out of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr D. Reynolds was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

JAY PEE BEE (NZ) (L. Halliday) - near the 1400 metres shifted in onto EVENING SPICE, which was obliged to be eased. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in the early stages of the race.

MONRAAJ (D. Tourneur) - from its wide barrier shifted in to obtain cover. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(b) and to ensure he rode his mounts out to the end of the race in future.

AUSSIE JACK (M. Collett) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 700 metres was obliged to be eased when tightened onto GALCRUM as DETENTORE (NZ) rolled in.

MY MATE SONNY (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung out rounding the home turn.

SCOTCH O'CLOCK (E. Boyd) - weakened from in the vicinity of the 200 metres. Rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SASSY MANEUVER (P. Gatt) - on arrival at the barriers, the tongue tie was required to be readjusted. Shortly after the entrance to the straight rolled out taking DETENTORE (NZ) wider.

AMERIWIN (J. Toeroek) - at the entrance to the straight, raced in restricted room for a short distance between JOCKS GLEN and SASSY MANEUVER.

EVENING SPICE (S. So) - made heavy contact with a perimeter fence on exiting the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 1400 metres was obliged to be eased as JAY PEE BEE (NZ) shifted in.
