RACE 1: FURPHY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres

CASHIN' CHEX (NZ) (K. Crowther) - tightened at the start between KING SLIM and OUR JOURNEYMAN.

EAGLE'S WINGS (S. Logan) - inside the 600 metres became awkward inside the heels of DON'T BLAME DIXIE for a number of strides.

JUSTEDEE (J. Eaton) - inside the 600 metres was obliged to shift out and away from the heels of EAGLE'S WINGS as that horse became awkward on the heels of runners and as a consequence, shifted into the running line of CHRYSOS taking that horse wider, resulting in CHRYSOS being hampered. Laid in, in the straight.

KING SLIM (C. Jones) - taken in at the start. Commenced to weaken shortly after the entrance to the straight and was eased from the event from near the 200 metres.

NONAME LANE (T. Pannell) - laid out from rounding the home turn.

OUR JOURNEYMAN (E. Boyd) - near the 600 metres became awkward on the heels of MISSALLURE for a number of strides.

BIGNOTA (J. Maund) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event and was taken a little wider inside the 600 metres by CHRYSOS, which shifted out.

RACE 1: FURPHY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres (Cont'd)

CHRYSOS (B. Vorster) - shifted in at the start onto KING SLIM, which was taken in onto CASHIN' CHEX (NZ), which was tightened. Inside the 600 metres was hampered when awkward outside the heels of JUSTEDEE as that horse shifted out and away from the heels of EAGLE'S WINGS. As a consequence CHRYSOS was hampered, shifted out and took BIGNOTA a little wider on the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DON'T BLAME DIXIE (A. Jordsjo) - commenced to weaken near the entrance to the straight and was eased from the event by its rider. Rider reported the gelding travelled well, however, near the 600 metres became awkward in its action and at the same time commenced to make excess respiratory noises. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Mr D Clarcken the co-trainer of DON'T BLAME DIXIE was advised that in view of the gelding's performance it was now suspended from racing and must perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an official barrier trial before being allowed to start in a race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISSALLURE (J. Holder) - shifted out at the start onto OUR JOURNEYMAN, which was taken out onto CASHIN' CHEX (NZ), which was tightened.

AQAAREB (S. Fawke) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

FREE TO DANCE (J. Maund) - Trainer Mr C. Bieg advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics that being that he would instruct his rider to restrain early and attempt to settle back in the event. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUSTY HALO (D. Tootell) - commenced to race fiercely from inside the 700 metres for some distance until in the vicinity of the 600 metres. Near the entrance to the straight was hampered and had to be steadied when awkward outside the heels of HEAVY ROTATION as that horse commenced to shift out in an attempt to improve. Thereafter approaching the 100 metres was obliged to shift to the outside of BARACONI, which commenced to weaken, after becoming awkward on that horse's heels.

SEA WITNESS (C. Jones) - knuckled at the start.

WAR CHEVAL (S. Fawke) - laid out in the straight. Near the 200 metres laid out and shifted out resulting in BARACONI shifting out and away from WAR CHEVAL. Thereafter, inside the 100 metres shifted out and inconvenienced HEAVY ROTATION. Rider was reminded of his obligations and to ensure he straightens his mounts as soon as they commence to shift ground.

ASTON EXPRESS (S. Logan) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BARACONI (J. Holder) - near the 200 metres shifted out and away from WAR CHEVAL, which laid out and shifted out and as a consequence shifted towards HEAVY ROTATION, which was taken out onto NANA DULCE which was severely hampered and had to be checked when tightened onto the heels of ROCABELLA. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FREE OF SIN (J. Toeroek) - was awkward to begin. Held up for clear running from near the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres.

RACE 2: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE
- 1050 Metres (Cont'd)

NANA DULCE (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out and away from VENDETTA at the start onto HEAVY ROTATION, which was inconvenienced. Approaching the 200 metres when attempting to improve between ROCABELLA and ASTON EXPRESS was unable to claim that ground as ROCABELLA shifted out slightly, and was obliged to shift to the inside of ROCABELLA in an attempt to obtain clear running and shortly thereafter was hampered by HEAVY ROTATION, which was taken out by BARACONI, which shifted out and away from WAR CHEVAL which laid out and shifted out, and as a consequence NANA DULCE was severely hampered and had to be checked when tightened onto the heels of ROCABELLA.

HEAVY ROTATION (T. Voorham) - was hampered at the start. Shortly after the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve and hampered RUSTY HALO, which had to be steadied when awkward outside the heels of HEAVY ROTATION. Rider was severely reprimanded for shifting ground when insufficiently clear. Near the 200 metres was taken out by BARACONI, which shifted out and away from WAR CHEVAL, which laid out and shifted out and as a consequence tightened NANA DULCE onto the heels of ROCABELLA resulting in NANA DULCE having to be checked when severely hampered. Inside the 100 metres was inconvenienced by WAR CHEVAL, which when laid out and shifted out under riding.

RACE 3: TAB LONG MAY WE PLAY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

DALAKARA (P. Gatt) - laid in near the 700 metres and thereafter laid in throughout in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DISSOLVABLE (D. Tourneur) - inside the 300 metres had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty, Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by D. Tourneur and noted that he only used his whip on one occasion over the last 100 metres.

ULTIMATE VIEW (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WINTER HARBOUR (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

BATTLE BLITZ (J. Holder) - was awkward to begin.

DISS 'N' DAT (S. Logan) - raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the event.

KHESHIG (NZ) (T. Voorham) - was hampered shortly after the start by SHADOW BOOM, which shifted out. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

NICCONI EXPRESS (B. Vorster) - raced greenly in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHADOW BOOM (K. Crowther) - shifted out shortly after the start and hampered KHESHIG (NZ). Approaching the 800 metres became awkward on the heels of WINTER HARBOUR as the pace slackened and shifted out tightening BLACK CHEVAL.

BLACK CHEVAL (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Approaching the 800 metres was tightened onto NICCONI EXPRESS by SHADOW BOOM, which shifted out when awkward on the heels of WINTER HARBOUR as the pace slackened.

RACE 4: TAB CREATE YOUR SPRING CALENDAR HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

SALOME (T. Pannell) - laid out in the straight.

RACE 4: TAB CREATE YOUR SPRING CALENDAR HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

THE HAITIAN POET (K. Zechner) - laid out in the straight. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(i) for using his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

ASTON RAPOVA (R. Hurdle) - was awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted LORNE. Inclined to lay out in the early part of the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ENLIST (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LORNE (B. Vorster) - contacted at the start. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5: PORSCHE CENTRE ADELAIDE HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

FLYING PIERRO (J. Toeroek) - was held up for clear running from approaching the 500 metres and near the 400 metres became awkward on the heels of HAHNDORF, which was weakening and was inconvenienced and thereafter was only able to obtain clear running from near the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MEEHNI (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

HOLY SANGRIA (J. Maund) - raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the event. Commenced to weaken from inside the 700 metres and took no competitive part from that point onwards. Rider reported the mare did not feel comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LITTLEBITFUNNY (A. Jordsjo) - was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 6: AAMI HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

EXALTED GOLD (S. Logan) - laid out in the straight.

EXALTED QUEEN (R. Hurdle) - shifted in approaching the 100 metres taking SONIC DEED in onto CELINE, which was hampered.

AFTER YOU (A. Jordsjo) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from shortly after the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CELINE (J. Toeroek) - approaching the 100 metres was hampered when tightened by SONIC DEED, which was taken in by EXALTED QUEEN, which shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SONIC DEED (D. Tourneur) - approaching the 100 metres was taken in by EXALTED QUEEN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ISSARA (P. Gatt) - was held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres.

SHARPLY ATTIRED (K. Zechner) - was awkward to begin. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 7: ZILZIE WINES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

VALLIANO (R. Hurdle) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

RACE 7: ZILZIE WINES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

MOTELL (P. Gatt) - laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TWICE FORGOTTEN (K. Zechner) - approaching the 1000 metres shifted in and inconvenienced THE IRON LADY.

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (B. Vorster) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

THE IRON LADY (K. Crowther) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres was inconvenienced by TWICE FORGOTTEN, which shifted in.

HE WILL BOOM (D. Tourneur) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$400. In determining penalty, Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by D. Tourneur and noted that he used his whip on five occasions over the last 100 metres, however, Stewards also considered his record and noted that he had a poor record in respect of whip breaches.

GRAVITY (D. Tootell) - was awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: TERRY HOWE PRINTING SKYBEAU STAYERS SERIES FINAL - 2500 Metres

DARLAMAX (J. Holder) - was very awkward to begin. Laid in, in the straight and from in the vicinity of the 100 metres was taken out by HASTA LA FIORENTE, which shifted out under riding.

ACE OF CLUBS (C. Lions) - lost its near hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA FIORENTE (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event, and from in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted out under riding taking DARLAMAX wider on the track.

KARPOOL KHAN (NZ) (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FRANKED (GB) (J. Eaton) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IRONICAL (A. Jordsjo) - was hampered at the start. Rider reported her horse became keen in the early stages and commenced to lay in shortly thereafter.

MAGUS MAN (D. Tootell) - Trainer Mr G. Young advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics that being that he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle back in the field. Shifted out at the start and hampered IRONICAL. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight was delayed to allow J. Holder (DARLAMAX) placed second and Mr T. Stokes representing Trainer Mr A. Homann to view the vision in the straight. After doing so, J. Holder lodged a protest against HASTA LA FIORENTE (D. Tourneur) being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference from in the vicinity of the 250 metres to the finish. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied that DARLAMAX would have beaten HASTA LA FIORENTE and in the circumstances *dismissed* the protest.

RACE 9: WESLO SECURITY HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

LANCASTER SOUND (T. Pannell) - was awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted RUSHWA. Laid out in the straight.

RACE 9: WESLO SECURITY HANDICAP - 1050 Metres (Cont'd)

NIC'S SECRET (R. Hurdle) - shifted out at the start onto **GOOD LUCK CHUCK**, which was taken out onto **ZUME FORWARD**, which was inconvenienced. Rider was spoken to with regard to using his whip in a manner that raised his arm above shoulder height over the concluding stages.

VEGAN (P. Gatt) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres was contacted by **ZUME FORWARD**, which shifted in to improve and as a consequence was taken in.

WOULDA THOUGHT SO (J. Holder) - was inclined to lay in, in the early part of the straight. From near the entrance to the straight had difficulty obtaining clear running when racing behind **ANAMNESIS** and was obliged to shift to that horse's outside, near the 200 metres, to obtain clear running. Rider explained on straightening he raced to the outside of **ZUME FORWARD** and behind **ANEMNESIS**, and owing to the position of **ZUME FORWARD** he was unable to shift in to improve and was obliged to maintain his position behind **ANEMNESIS** and ride for luck. When questioned about his option to improve to the outside of **ANEMNESIS** he stated that the run between **ANEMNESIS** and **LOHN RANGER** to his outside was a tight run and he considered that it would not be an option to attempt. He added that just prior to the 200 metres he made an attempt to shift to the inside of **ANEMNESIS** to improve but was again unable to gain clear ground owing to the position of **ZUME FORWARD**, and was obliged to shift out over the heels of **ANEMNESIS** to gain clear running. He also added that the gelding finished the race off in a manner which suggested it may benefit from racing over longer distances. Stewards noted his explanation.

GOOD LUCK CHUCK (S. Fawke) - was taken out at the start. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

RUSHWA (J. Toeroek) - was contacted at the start.

ANAMNESIS (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZUME FORWARD (K. Zechner) - was inconvenienced at the start. Near the 100 metres when improving onto the heels of **PALE ALE** shifted in to obtain clear running and in doing so, contacted **VEGAN**, which rolled out slightly at the same time, resulting in **VEGAN** being inconvenienced. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.
