STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 11 August 2018

RACE 1: IRISH RACE DAY - 1ST SEPTEMBER AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1300 metres

ANOTHER BIT (T. Pannell) – shifted out at the start and contacted CARLALUISA.

BINDING FORCE (K. Crowther) – laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JUST ROLLING (J. Kah) – near the 1200 metres was contacted by CARLALUISA as that horse rolled out and as a consequence became awkward on the heels of BINDING FORCE for a number of strides and lost its position.

CARLALUISA (R. Clark) – contacted at the start and near the 1200 metres, rolled out contacted JUST ROLLING, which was taken out and became awkward on the heels of BINDING FORCE and lost its position.

RACE 2: UBET HANDICAP – 1550 metres

TEMPS VOLEUR (J. Huxtable) – rider was dislodged from his mount en route to the start when the gelding turned sharply unbalancing him. The gelding then galloped a short distance before being captured by the Clerk of the Course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. J. Huxtable was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and was passed fit to ride.

BY THE GRACE (J. Kah) – lost its off fore plate during the event.

RED CHOUX'S (NZ) (K. Crowther) – laid in, in the straight. Performed below expectations. Rider could offer no explanation other than in her opinion, the gelding may not have been suited to today's underfoot conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MEDVEDEV (J. Potter) – laid out in the straight.

ALITAKA (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: QUAYCLEAN HANDICAP – 1300 metres

BOGGOMS (D. Tourneur) – near the 1000 metres raced in restricted room inside EMBECEE LIL, which shifted in and had to be restrained for several strides when tightened. A post-race veterinary examination revealed signs of tying up in both hind legs and lameness in both hind legs. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

EMBECEE LIL (T. Pannell) – shifted in near the 1000 metres when insufficiently clear and tightened BOGGOMS for several strides. Rider reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground.

HAZY LANE (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NIPPERKIN (K. Bishop) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

RACE 4: AAMI HANDICAP - 2400 metres

MONGOLIAN WOLF (K. Crowther) – stood flat-footed and was slow to begin.

THE WILLYBE (NZ) (D. Tourneur) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HARDINGTON (GB) (P. Gatt) – fractious in its barrier and a little awkward to begin.

CAROUN (IRE) (R. Sakai) - raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the event.

MICKIEM (A. Chan) - Trainer Mr R. Daniel advised Stewards prior to the event that he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle forward of mid-field.

Stewards noted that MICKIEM and SUDDEN MOMENT were presented 20 minutes later than required and questioned Trainer Mr R. Daniel in respect of the geldings being presented late on course. Mr Daniel explained that he had misjudged his timing and for that reason the horse was presented late. Mr Daniel was reprimanded under AR117 and LR8.9 for presenting the geldings late on course.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Stewards, the Starter and P. Gatt to view the start in relation to HARDINGTON (GB).

RACE 5:ADELAIDE IMAGE PRINTING HANDICAP - 1250 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately eight minutes owing to BELLOMO proving difficult to leave the mounting yard, becoming very fractious and pulling its off hind plate. Consequently, BELLOMO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and Farrier following which a decision was made for BELLOMO to proceed to the barriers to be re-shod and examined prior to participating in the race. However, after leaving the mounting yard BELLOMO proved very difficult and refused to proceed to the start and was declared a late scratching at 2.55 pm by order of Stewards. While the gelding proved difficult, DOMINATION, which was in the mounting yard waiting for a Clerk of the Course to be led to the barriers pulled its near fore plate. A decision was made to allow DOMINATION to proceed to the start to be re-shod and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon. After arrival at the barriers, DOMINATION was re-shod, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race.

DAKTARI (R. Clark) – awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed cardiac arrhythmia and post-race distress. First aid administered. Trainer advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

BALWARRA GOLD (E. Finnegan) – on arrival at the barriers E. Finnegan was struck in the face by the gelding. E. Finnegan was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to ride. Hang out for a short distance near the 600 metres.

RACE 5: ADELAIDE IMAGE PRINTING HANDICAP - 1250 metres (Cont'd)

RAIZA FLAME (A. Chan) – Stewards noted that RAIZA FLAME was presented on course 20 minutes later than required and questioned Mr J. Dentith, the stable representative for Mr S. Eden and Racing Manager Mr G. Scott in respect of the gelding being presented late on course. Mr Dentith explained that they had mistakenly worked on Melbourne time printed in the race book and for that reason the horse was presented late. Mr Dentith was reprimanded under AR117 and LR8.9 for presenting the gelding late on course. Laid out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BY THE POUND (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

DOMINATION (J. Kah) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained the gelding over-raced in the early and middle stages, failed to respond to her riding from the entrance to the straight and was disappointing over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOUBLE POCKETS (J. Potter) – laid out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: WELCOME ARCHIE NUNN HANDICAP - 1950 metres

FINN MCCOOL (IRE) (P. Gatt) – commenced to weaken from the entrance to the straight and was inclined to lay out for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROCK ON IVY (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. Rider accidentally dropped her whip approaching the 100 metres and was fined \$50 for carelessness in dropping her whip under AR137(a).

NACAR (GER) (J. Allen) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

MORE THAN FABULOUS (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OBSCURA (J. Huxtable) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANOULI (J. Holder) – difficult to load, thereafter fractious in its barrier and reared as the start was effected and lost three to four lengths. Trainer Mr J. Hickmott was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its loading and barrier manners. Approaching the 400 metres became awkward for several strides on the heels of FINN MCCOOL (IRE), which commenced to weaken and had to be steadied as a consequence. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: MYPUNTER.COM HANDICAP - 1000 metres

LOVE MAGIC (R. Clark) - Trainer Mr W. Bencic failed to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards.

NODOUBTABOUTIT (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

BELLA VINO (J. Kah) – rider reported the mare travelled well until near the entrance to the straight, however was disappointing and failed to finish the event off as expected. In her opinion, the mare may not have been suited to the track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: PINOT PALOOZA HANDICAP - 1400 metres

DR DAPPER (E. Boyd) – near the 1350 metres was severely hampered when tightened between GALAXY GAZER to its inside, which maintained its line and STRYKER FORTUNE, which shifted in after receiving pressure from its outside resulting in contact between STRYKER FORTUNE and DR DAPPER. As a consequence of the contact DR DAPPER had its hindquarters turned.

SAVANERO (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) – shifted in shortly after the start and crossed the running of STRYKER FORTUNE, which was momentarily inconvenienced.

ROSELLI STING (R. Hurdle) – awkward to begin and laid in, in the early stages of the event. Near the 1350 metres was taken in for several strides by SNOWBROOK, which shifted in. As a consequence ROSELLI STING contacted STRYKER FORTUNE, which was tightened onto DR DAPPER, resulting in STRYKER FORTUNE being severely hampered, having to be checked and losing its position.

SAVE ME NED (R. Sakai) – reared after leaving the mounting enclosure en route to the start and lost its rider, who was uninjured in the incident. Thereafter the mare galloped a short distance towards the 1800 metres chute where it lost its footing and fell. SAVE ME NED regained its footing and shortly thereafter was captured by the Clerk of the Course. SAVE ME NED was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 4.50 pm as a consequence.

SNOWBROOK (K. Crowther) – shortly after the start after initially following ROSELLI STING inwards, allowed her mount to shift in near the 1350 metres onto ROSELLI STING tightening that horse onto STRYKER FORTUNE, which was severely hampered when tightened onto DR DAPPER. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to straighten her mounts sooner than she did on this occasion.

VALLIANO (T. Pannell) – had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the 400 metres to near the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AUTUMN STREET (J. Huxtable) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRYKER FORTUNE (E. Finnegan) – shortly after the start was inconvenienced and thereafter near the 1350 metres was tightened between ROSELLI STING, which was taken in by SNOWBROOK and DR DAPPER to her inside. As a consequence was severely hampered and had to be checked and lost her position. Rider reported that as a consequence of her losing her position shortly after the start, she was unable to settle in a more forward position as intended.

ROWDY RICHARD (A. Chan) – reared and was slow into stride and from inside the 600 metres commenced to weaken. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr K. Sweeney was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed ROWDY RICHARD would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop a 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

Race 6 – NACAR (GER) – Not to race - Vet Cert of Fitness required prior to future trial or race – Lame near foreleg. Race 8 – ROWDY RICHARD – Suspended for 3 months – AR53A - Required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race – Bi-lateral bleed.
